

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-OGR-002 Series of 2024

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT OF BARANAGAY DANSOLIHON, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Barangay Dansolihon of Cagayan de Oro City is committed to the protection, preservation and conservation of the ecosystem;

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the barangay to effectively and efficiently implement the Ecological Social Waste Management under Republic Act No. 9003 in its territorial jurisdiction:

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code (RA 7160) also provides that:

"SEC. 16 General Welfare. - Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.

WHEREAS, the unsystematic waste disposal by household, commercial and industrial establishments and other organizational institutions causes unlikable surroundings and spread of communicable diseases;

WHEREAS, the practice of waste segregation at source that facilitates reuse, reduce and recycling does not only reduce the cost of collection and disposal of garbage, but conserves the natural resources of materials and avoid wasteful consumption of goods;

NOW THEREFORE, on the motion of Kagawad Glenn B. Baslote, duly seconded by Kagawad Lizyl B. Lora.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BARANGAY COUNCIL OF BARANGAY DANSOLIHON, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

ARTICLE I - TITLE

Section 1. Title. – This Ordinance shall be known as the "ORDINANCE ON THE ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENTOF BARANGAY DANSOLIHON, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY"

ARTICLE II - COVERAGE

Section 2. Coverage. – This Ordinance shall apply to all residential houses; commercial establishments such as restaurants, eateries, department stores, groceries, sari-sari stores, auto repair shops, institutions like banks, clinics, schools, churches, public and private officers, industrial establishments of any kind; and other business areas situated within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Dansolihon, Cagayan de Oro City







ARTICLE III - LEGAL BASIS, PURPOSE, GOAL AND OBJECTIVES

Section 3. Legal Basis. This Ordinance is enacted to implement the provisions of Republic Act No. 9003 which mandates the proper segregation and collection of household wastes.

Section 4. Purpose. This Ordinance is enacted for thwe following purposes;

- 4.1. To guide, manage and regulate the generation of the solid waste within the Barangay and promote an orderly and sanitary system for the same;
- 4.2. To improve the total environment of the locality through the necessary control and mitigation of negative environmental impacts of solid waste;
- 4.3. To promote and protect the health, safety, peace and convenience of the general welfare of the inhabitants of the Barangay through proper garbage disposal;
- 4.4. To minimize the generation of solid waste and maximize possible recovery, reduction and recycling and utilization by;
 - (a) Encouraging the salvaging of possible "recoverable" from solid waste for re-use and/ or recycling back to production process; and
 - (b) Encouraging the recycling and resource recovery of waste s in own backyards through composting.

Section 5. Goal. The primary goal of this Ordinance is to enhance ecological balance of the community through sustainable and integrated waste management.

Section 6. Objectives. The Objectives of this ordinance are the Following:

- 6.1. To ensure round-the-clock cleanliness through the orderly management of waste;
- 6.2. To eradicate unsightly, uncovered and overflowing waste containers in streets, public places and open spares;
- 6.3. To maximize and optimize sanitary resource recovery for feeds, materials and others;
- 6.4. To maximize pollution arising from harmful gases, smoke particles produced by needless burning/dumping, polluted runoffs into water sources/supply, and hazardous substances; and
- 6.5. To institutionalize the environmentally acceptable practices by means of re-using, recycling and Reducing the generated waste in all entities in the community.

ARTICLE IV – DEFINATION OF TERMS

Section 7. Definition of Terms. As used in this Ordinance, the following term has its meaning, as follows:

- 7.1. Biodegradable shall refer to any materials that can be reduce into finer particles (degraded or decomposed) by microbiological organisms or enzymes (synonymous with compostable);
- 7.2. Biodegradable Waste shall consist of fruit & vegetable peeling, spoiled food & leftovers, vegetables trimmings, fish scales, egg shells, seafood shells, animal entrails & carcasses, corn cobs & sheaths, rice hulls, peanut shells, wet newspapers & cardboards, wet papers & cartoons, coconut shells & husk, seeds, garden & grass clippings, pet/poultry/livestock manure, chipped branches and sawdust;
- 7.3. Bulky Waste shall refer to the used rubber tires; garden debris; destroyed TV sets, radios, stereos, washing machines, dryers, stoves, refrigerators & dishwashers, broken furniture, filing cabinets, book cases, beds & cushions;







- 7.4. Collection shall refer to the act of removing solid waste from all source or from a communal storage point.
- 7.5. Compost shall refer to the decayed organic material for use as soil conditioner or fertilizer.
- 7.6. Composting shall refer to the biological degradation under controlled condition; the process of making biodegradables such as food waste, garden waste, animal waste, human waste into compost by mixing them with soil, water, biological additives and air;
- 7.7. Disposal shall refer to the discharge, deposit, dumping, spilling, leaking or placing of any solid waste into or in any land.
- 7.8. Domestic Waste shall refer to used waste from households, as distinguished from industrial waste, hospital waste, etc. which may be classified as biodegradable (compostable) or non-biodegradable (non-compostable)
- 7.9. Ecological Solid Waste Management shall refer to the systematic administration of activities which provide for segregation at source, segregated transportation, storage, transfer processing, treatment and disposal of solid waste and all other waste management activities which do not harm the environment;
- 7.10. Environmentally acceptable refer to the quality of being re-usable, biodegradable or compostable, recyclable and not toxic or hazardous to the environment;
- 7.11. Generation shall refer to the act or process of producing solid waste
- 7.12. Generator shall refer to a person, natural or juridical, who last uses a material and makes available for disposal or recycling;
- 7.13. Hazardous Waste shall refer to solid waste or combination of solid waste which because of its quantity, concentration, or physical, or chemical, or infectious characteristic may;
 - (a) cause, or significantly contribute to an increase in mortality or an increase in serious irreversible, or incapacitating reversable, or illness; or
 - (b) pose a substantial present or potential hazard to human health or the environment when improperly treated, stored, transported, or disposed of, or otherwise manages;
- 7.14. Material Recovery Facility (MRF) shall include a solid waste transfer station or sorting station, drop-off center, a composting facility, and a recycling facility;
- 7.15. **Open dump** shall refer to a disposal area wherein the solid wastes are indiscriminately thrown or disposed of without due planning and consideration for environmental and health standards;
- 7.16. **Receptacles** shall refer to individual containers used for the source separation and the collection of the recyclable materials;
- 7.17. **Recyclable Wastes** shall consist of dry papers & newspapers, dry cardboards & cartons, plastic materials like plastic containers, plastic water bottles, plastic bottles caps, PVC & PE pipes, computer casing, tin cans & covers, aluminum cans, iron steel, copper wires, broken transparent glasses, glass bottles, toner cartridges, computer inks cartridges;
- 7.18. **Recycling** shall refer to the treating of used or waste materials through a process of making them suitable for beneficial use and for other purposes, and includes any process by which solid waste materials are transformed into new products in such a manner that the original products may lose their identity, and which may be used as raw materials for the production of other goods and services:
- 7.19. **Residual Wastes** shall consist of sando bags, packing wrappers. styropors or styrofoams, cigarette butts, worn out plastic sacks, dirt from sweepings, worn out rags, sanitary napkins, disposable diapers. plastic straws, parlor & barbershop waste, household medicine bottles. broken ceramics, colored broken glasses, coco fiber from cushions. poultry feathers:
- 7.20. **Resource conservation** shall refer to the reduction of the amount of solid waste that are generated or the reduction of overall consumption. and utilization of recovered resources.







- 7.21. **Resource recovery** shall refer to the collection, extraction or recover of recyclable materials from the waste stream for the purpose of recycling, generating energy or producing a product suitable for beneficial use:
- 7.22. **Re-use** shall refer to the process of recovering materials intended for the same or differentpurpose without the alteration of physical and chemical characteristics;
- 7.23. Segregation shall refer to a solid waste management practice of separating different materials found in solid waste in order to promote recycling and re-use of resources and to reduce the volume of waste for collection and disposal:
- 7.24. Segregation at source shall refer to a solid waste management practice of separating, at the point of origin, different materials found in solid waste in order to promote recycling and re- use of resources and reduce the volume of waste for collection and disposal:
- 7.25. Solid Waste shall refer to all discarded household, commercial waste non-hazardous institutional and industrial waste, street sweepings. construction debris, agricultural waste, and other non-hazardous/non- toxic solid waste.

Unless specifically noted otherwise, the term "solid waste" as used in this act shall not include:

- (a) waste identified or listed as hazardous waste of a solid, liquid. contained gaseous or semisolid form which may cause or contribute to an increase in mortality or in serious or in serious or incapacitating reversible illness, acute/chronic effect on the health of persons and other organisms;
- (b) infectious waste from hospital such as equipment, instruments. utensils, and fomites of a disposable nature from patients who are suspected to have or have been diagnosed as having communicable diseases and must therefore be isolated as required by public health agencies, laboratory waste such as pathological specimens (i.e., all tissues, specimens of blood elements, and excreta, and secretions obtained from patients or laboratory animals), and disposable fomites that may harbor or transmit pathogenic organisms, and surgical operating room pathologic specimens and disposable fomites attendant thereto, and similar disposable materials from outpatient areas and emergency rooms; and
- (c) waste resulting from mining activities, including contaminated soil and debris.
- 7.26. Solid waste management shall refer to the discipline associated with the control of generation, storage, collection. transfer and transport, processing, and disposal of solid waste in a manner that is in accord with the best principles of public health, economics, engineering. conservation, aesthetics, and other environmental considerations, and that is also responsive to public attitudes;
- 7.27. Source separation shall refer to the sorting of solid waste into some or all of its component parts at the point of generation;
- 7.28. **Special Wastes** shall consist of paint and thinner containers, spray canisters, household batteries, pharmaceutical waste, spoiled, spilled, expired cosmetics waste, lead-acid batteries, used oil filters, broken tiles;
- 7.29. Storage shall refer to the interim containment of solid waste after generation and prior to collection for ultimate recovery or disposal.

ARTICLE V - SEGREGATION OF WASTE

Section 8. Mandatory Segregation of Solid Wastes. The segregation of wastes shall primarily be conducted at the source (segregation at source), to include household. institutional, industrial, commercial and agricultural sources. The generators from the households, institutional industrial and commercial establishments, should able







to practice segregation at source as means to properly manage waste at hand before it is being transported to the dropping site.

Section 9. Requirements for the Segregation and Storage of Solid Waste.

Pending Collection. The following shall be the minimum standards and requirements for segregation and storage of solid pending collection:

- 9.1. There should be a suitable container such as a plastic bag or the like for the ecological solid waste before these are brought out along the streets or brought out at the assigned dropping areas.
- 9.2. There should be a separate receptacle for each type of waste from sources: provided, that in the case of bulky waste, it will suffice that the same be collected and placed in a separate and designated area: and
- 9.3. For all commercial and industrial establishments, there should be solid waste receptacles depending on its use shall be properly marked or identified for on-site collection as follows:
 - (a) BIODEGRADABLES/COMPOSTABLES OR "NABUBULOK"
 - (b) RECYCLABLES OR "DI-NABUBULOK NA MAAARI PANG PAKINABANGAN"; and
 - (c) RESIDUALS & SPECIAL WASTE OR "DI-NABUBULOK NA DI NA MAPAPAKINABANGAN."

ARTICLE VI - COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL

Section 10. Collection/Drop-off Points/Areas. All zones/street must have designated strategic collection/drop-off points/areas to facilitate the hauling of segregated solid waste materials of the barangay.

- 10.1. Only segregated solid waste materials must be brought to the Zonal Material Facility (MRF) or at the collection points at the time and date of collection; and
- 10.2. A personnel must be assigned in every collection point to ensure that the delivered solid wastes are properly segregated.

Section 11. Sanitary Crews/Sanitary Aides/Green Brigade of Eco Aide Team. The barangay must assign a Sanitary Crews/Sanitary Aides, who will be called as a Green Brigade of Eco-Aide Team, to check the delivered solid waste materials and handle the transfer of segregated solid waste material from the Zonal MRF or from the collection points to the garbage truck during collection. The Green Brigade of Eco-Aide Team will also conduct house-to-house monitoring to check if the segregation at source is properly institutionalized. Moreover, the Eco-Brigade Team is given the authority to impose penalties to those who deliberately violate this Ordinance.

Section 12. Collection of Segregated Waste Materials at the Barangay. The City Garbage Compactor through the City Ecological Solid Waste Management Task Force shall be responsible agent in the collection of residual waste at the Zonal Material Recovery Facility (MRF) or at its collection points because the barangay has no capacity of transporting this type of waste.

Section 13. Schedule of Residual Waste Materials Collection at the Barangay. The schedule collection for the accumulated residual waste materials at the barangay will be determined in coordination with the barangay concern and be properly disseminated by the CLENRO.

Section 14. Residential Areas. The garbage shall be collected through a system of collection within the barangay.







Section 15. Commercial, Industrial and Other Business Establishments. All garbage in these locations shall also be collected in the same manner as in Section 10.

Section 16. Industrial Areas. All factories and plants shall separate their garbage into toxic and non-toxic. It is mandatory that all factories contact the industrial waste exchange (IWE) to exchange their wastes with others who may be able to use them. Existing industrial areas already having their proper way of collection and disposal shall continue practicing the same.

Section 18. Time of Dumping. Time of dumping of ecological solid wastes for collection at the collection/ dropoff points/sites shall be from Six to Eight O'clock in the morning (6:00-8:00 AM) for BIODEGRADABLE and from Four to Five O'clock in the evening (4:00-5:00 PM) for RESIDUAL

ARTICLE VII - PROHIBITED ACTS

Section 19. Prohibited Acts. The following acts are prohibited and its corresponding Fines and Penalties:

- 19.1. No stationed solid waste receptacles outside the establishments that are properly marked or identified as a) Biodegradable/ Compostables or "Nabubulok (b) Recyclables or "Di-Nabubulok na Maari Pang Pakinabangan", and (c) Residuals & Special Waste or "Di-Nabubulok na 'Di na Mapapakinabangan";
- 19.2. Bringing out and dumping of garbage outside of collection day and proper time of dumping for collection;
- 19.3. Indiscriminately dumping garbage littering, throwing, dumping of solid waste matters in public places, such as roads, sidewalks, canals, drainage systems, curbs and gutters, esteros or parks, creeks, rivers, tributaries, rivulets and other natural waterways, and establishment, or causing or permitting the same;
- 19.4. The open and indiscriminate burning of solid wastes;
- 19.5. Open dumping, burying of biodegradable or non-biodegradable materials in flood-prone areas;
- 19.6. Unauthorized removal of recyclable materials intended for collection by authorized persons;
- 19.7. The mixing of source-separated recyclable material with other solid waste in any vehicle, box, container or receptacle used in solid waste collection or disposal
- 19.8. Violations shall be accounted per household and the head of the family shall be responsible in the implementation of the Ordinance in their respective household. In effect, any violation committed by the household shall be carried by all members of the said household except household helps, transient visitors, and other temporary or visiting individuals.
- 19.9. Violators shall not be given Barangay Clearance and Certifications until he/she/it has paid and/or served his/her/its fines/penalties. The names of those violators will also be posted at conspicuous places in the barangay

Section 20. Utilization of Collected Fines. Thirty percent (30%) of collected fines shall accrue to the General Fund for appropriations for the next fiscal year and the remaining seventy percent (709%), which shall be called as Barangay Ecological Solid Waste Management (ESWM) Fund shall be used for the following within the fiscal year of which the fines were collected:

- 20.1. Honoraria for the Barangay Dansolihon Green Brigade for Eco-Aides Team, who is composed of the Sanitary Crews. Sanitary Aides and its equivalence;
- 20.2. Procurement of materials, equipment, protective gears and other items necessary for the proper implementation of the Ecological Solid Waste Management of Barangay Dansolihon, Cagayan de Oro City;







- 20.3. Information, education, communication and monitoring activities of the Ecological Solid Waste Management of Barangay Dansolihon, Cagayan de Oro City;
- 20.4. Acquisition of products, facilities, technologies and processes necessary to enhance proper ecological solid waste management.;
- 20.5. Transportation, Hauling of ecological solid wastes;
- 20.6. Awards and incentives;
- 20.7. Research program;
- 20.8. Technical Assistance;
- 20.9. Capability-building activities; and
- 20.10. Maintenance and other related activities program, etc, for the Zonal Materials Recovery Facility.

ARTICLE IX - MISCELLANEOS PROVISIONS

Section 21. Citizen Suits. For purposed of enforcing the provisions of the Ordinance, any citizen may file an appropriate civil or criminal action in the barangay against any person who violates or fails to comply with the provisions of the Ordinance. The Barangay concerned shall exempt such action from payment of filling fees.


Section 22. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstances is declared unconstitutional, the remainder of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected by such declaration.

Section 23. Repealing Clause. All existing ordinances and resolutions of this barangay found to be inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 24. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government of 1991.





LEGASPI, JR., MD, MPH, FPSMS, CESO IV in his official capacity as DIRECTOR IV, and hereafter referred to as "FIRST PARTY";

The CITY OF CAGAYAN DE ORO, a government entity duly existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at, 89 HAYES STREET, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY for and on behalf of the JR BORJA GENERAL HOSPITAL, herein represented by HON. ROLANDO A. UY in the official capacity as CITY MAYOR, and hereafter referred to as "SECOND PARTY";

Hereafter collectively referred to as "Parties"

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 11712 known as the *Public Health Emergency* Benefits and Allowances for Health Care Workers Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) provides for the payment of Health Emergency Allowance (HEA), Sickness and Death Compensation and other Benefits for public and private health care workers (HCWs) and non-HCWs during the COVID-19 pandemic and other future public health emergencies with retroactive application starting July 1, 2021;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the same Act stipulates that the amount of HEA shall vary based on the risk exposure categorization of the HCWs and non-HCWs in particular setting: three thousand pesos (Php 3,000.00) for low risk, six thousand pesos (Php 6,000.00) for medium risk, and nine thousand pesos (Php 9,000.00) for high risk;

WHEREAS, the DOH Administrative Order (AO) No. 2022-0001-A or the Amendment to Administrative Order No. 2022-0001 entitled "COVID-19 Risk Exposure Classification of Healthcare Workers" was issued to set the parameters for determining the risk exposure of personnel in COVID-19 response-involved health facilities;

WHEREAS, the DOH - Department of Budget and Management (DBM) issued Joint Administrative Order (JAO) No. 2023-0001, dated October 16, 2023 entitled "Guidelines on the Grant of Health Emergency Allowance to Public Health Care Workers (HCWs) and Non-HCWs During the State of Public Health Emergency Due to COVID-19" to provide guidelines for a rationalized identification of eligible health facilities;

WHEREAS, RA No. 11936 General Appropriations Act (GAA) FY 2023 and RA No. 11975 or the GAA FY 2024 has appropriated funds for the payment of arrears to the eligible HCWs and non-HCWs pursuant to RA 11712;

WHEREAS, the DOH issues a Department Order (DO) for every release of funds for payment of HEA, which provides for the specific guidelines on the sub-allotments/transfers and disbursement of the same;

Transfer funds to the SECOND PARTY in the amount based on the approved HEA torms for the grant of HEA to the eligible HCWs and non-HCWs, upon submission of the complete documentary requirements and upon the issuance of the FIRST PARTYs' corresponding Certificate of Availability of Funds, subject to pertinent accounting rules and regulations.

1.2. The actual amount of funds to be downloaded to the SECOND PARTY shall depend on the availability of funds and the approved HEA reports.

- 1.3. The **FIRST PARTY** shall issue the required Certificate of Availability of Funds (CAF) for every download. No separate MOA shall be required for subsequent transfer of funds and the issuance of the CAF shall suffice.
- 2. The **SECOND PARTY** shall:
 - 2.1. Submit the approved HEA forms and attestation form to the FIRST PARTY prior to transfer of funds.
 - 2.2. Facilitate the payment of HEA benefit to its eligible HCWs and non-HCWs based on the approved HEA forms as guided by DOH-DBM JAO No. 2023-0001 and DOH AO No. 2022-0039, as well as any other relevant issuances;
 - 2.3. Ensure that there is no duplicity of the names of the HCWs and non-HCWs;
 - 2.4. Require the HCWs and non-HCWs to sign a quitclaim with an undertaking to return the excess amount in case they receive HEA benefits more than once for the same month;
 - 2.5. Submit to the **FIRST PARTY** the final report on the number of eligible HCWs and non-HCWs who received the HEA benefits, as signed by the human resource personnel or personnel division and certified by the head of the facility;
 - 2.6. Comply with any other related guidelines that may be issued by the FIRST PARTY;
 - 2.7. Utilize the transferred funds for the intended purpose not later than *December* 31, 2024 and return to the **FIRST PARTY** any unutilized funds. In the event of an extension of the fund utilization as duly authorized by the Department of Health, the relevant issuance shall be deemed incorporated in this agreement, pursuant to Section IV herein;
 - 2.8. The SECOND PARTY shall submit to the FIRST PARTY a liquidation of the funds received containing no less than:
 - 2.8.1. Proof of payment/payroll signed by the recipients of the benefits;
 - 2.8.2. Fund Utilization Report duly approved and signed by the Chief Accountant and the Head of the Facility;
 - 2.8.3. Certification by the Chief Accountant or its equivalent that taxes are properly withheld and remitted to the BIR pursuant to applicable existing taxation rules and regulation;
 - 2.8.4. Report of Checks Issued (RCI) and the Report of Disbursement (RD) certified correct by the Chief Accountant and approved by the Head of the Facility.
- 3. The **PARTIES** shall ensure that processing of sensitive and personal information is strictly in observance with Republic Act 10173, or the Data Privacy Act of 2012 and all other related National Privacy Commission issuances.
- 4. No transfer of funds shall be made by the FIRST PARTY to the SECOND PARTY without the latter's submission of Fund Utilization Report of previously transferred funds.

SECTION II. TERM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall be effective from the date of its execution until the occurrence

Violation by the SECOND PARTY of this Agreement or any of the relevant issuances of the FIRST PARTY may be a ground for termination of this Agreement, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances.

Obligations which by nature are intended to continue beyond the termination of the Agreement shall survive such termination.



WHEREAS, LGU-CDO, USTP, and DepED-CDO believe in increasing the number of out-of-school youth, and adults who can complete formal basic education;

WHEREAS, LGU-CDO, USTP, and DepED-CDO consider that the out-of-school youth and adults at risk are vulnerable groups that need to achieve literacy, numeracy, and values formation which will enable them to contribute to sustainable development:

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the preceding premises, the herein PARTIES hereunto agreed to the following:

ARTICLE I PURPOSE

The purpose of this agreement is to establish a partnership to implement the Alternative Learning System-Night School Program (ALS-NSP), providing out-of-school youth and adults at risk in Cagayan de Oro with opportunities for formal basic education, literacy, numeracy, and values formation. The ALS-NSP aims to empower these individuals, reintegrate them into the education system, or prepare them for the Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) examination, supporting sustainable development. This collaboration aligns with the RISE Agenda of LGU-CDO, emphasizing education as a key tool for human development, and defines the roles and responsibilities of each party for effective program delivery and support.

ARTICLE II ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Section 1. LGU-CDO shall:

- a. Designate the Office of the City Education and Development Officer to mobilize the following:
 - i. Assignment of a focal person to coordinate smooth implementation of the program;
 - ii. Coordination with relevant stakeholders for access to flexible learning options and delivery of educational programs that provide basic literacy and numeracy skills, vocational training, and life skills to the targeted clientele;
 - iii. Partnerships and/or engagement with other stakeholders who may be able to offer apprenticeships and internships that provide hands-on experience;
 - iv. Access to mentors and counselors who can offer guidance, support and motivation;
 - v. Advocate for policies that support inclusive education, vocational training, and employment opportunities for out-of-school youth and adults at risk;
 - vi. Foster partnerships between government agencies, non-profits, educational institutions, and the private sector to create a comprehensive support network;
 - vii. Provision of tertiary and vocational education scholarships to qualified NSP beneficiaries/completers;
 - vili. Provision of certification of list of beneficiaries;
 - ix. Provision of PhP5,000.00 worth of operational support per learner endorsed by the Office of the City Social Welfare and Development Officer, which will be channeled to the partner learning institution. The coverage of the operational support shall be for learning materials and modules, load allowance, transportation allowance, meal allowance, supplemental food packs, uniform, and ALS-NSP ID;

- Convene the quarterly partnership meeting and serve as Secretariat for the program's monitoring, assessment, evaluation and feedback mechanisms;
- xi. Provide documentation reports or best practices for the program's successful implementation.
- b. Cause the Office of the City Social Welfare and Development Officer to designate one (1) CSWD personnel to ensure social welfare responsiveness to the program's clientele, to wit:
 - i. Assess and certify individuals needing help and manage cases of the program's beneficiaries/clientele/learners;
 - ii. Endorse clients to partner schools, concerned LGU department/offices, and and stakeholders who may be able to assist them finish at least basic education, gain employable skills, and land a job;
 - iii. Provide psycho-social consultation services to the learners;
 - iv. Organize outreach activities to identify children, youth, and adults at risk and connect them with available resources;
 - v. Mobilize critical quick response mechanism on man-made or natural disaster in humanitarian/emergency settings (flood, fire, earthquake, epidemic/pandemic crises) and provide legal assistance directly to highly vulnerable learners;
 - vi. Provide the required family interventions for parent-learners.
- c. Cause the Office of the Oro Youth Development Officer to carry out the following:
 - i. Arrange for safe spaces where youths at risk can gather for learning, socialization, and support;
 - ii. Proactively map and engage the out-of-school and maintain a database of their profile and needs;
 - iii. Assist the Oro Youth Center in its duty as a drop-in and referral center for the youth with problems such as teenage pregnancy, teenage prostitution, sexually transmitted disease/infection, boyfriend-girlfriend relationship concerns, parent-child relationship concerns, substance abuse, vagrancy and other anti-social behavior such truancy and vandalism, and other adolescent-related problems;
 - iv. Include ALS-NSP beneficiaries in their programs and activities that promote a broad understanding of the problems affecting the youth in highly urbanized areas;
 - v. Assign a focal person for the ALS-NSP.

Section 2. USTP shall:

a. Designate a program officer or focal person for the ALS-NSP;

- b. Partner with DepED-CDO-ALS in the orientation and capacity development for ALS volunteer/pre-service teachers;
- c. Promote the enrolment of preferred target beneficiaries within the adapted communities and submit the certificate of admission after three months of the commencement of classes to LGU-CDO through the Office of the City Education and Development Officer-City Scholarships Office;
- d. Mobilize student tutors or pre-service teachers who will handle supplemental activities and assist in values formation sessions;
- e. Co-facilitate the necessary orientation, capacity development, and guidelines for the ALS-NSP volunteers/pre-service teachers and student tutors;
- f. Provide classrooms for the use of the learning sessions;
- Permit ALS-NSP to use college/university facilities such as audio-visual rooms, theaters, ICT laboratories, and other learning facilities that will improve learners' learning;
- Monitor the conduct of the ALS-NSP classes;
- i. Ensure the safe environment of the ALS-NSP learners;
- j. Secure the permit from the USTP Security Office for the entrance, stay, and exit procedures of the ALS-NSP learners;
- k. Provide uniform and identification cards for the bonafide learners;
- I. Reproduce ALS-NSP learning modules and materials for the learners;
- m. Consult with the ALS-NSP teacher on the progress and performance of the learners;
- n. Endorse a list of the qualified ALS-NSP completers who will take the A&E exam;
- Assist completers with the needed documents for the A&E exam;
- p. Hold the graduation rites of the A&E passers;
- Refer A&E passers to educational and/or technical vocational opportunities and scholarships;
- r. Provide a financial report on all funds raised for the program, in cash or in-kind;
- s. Conduct annual evaluation of the program with partners and stakeholders; and

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t. Submit the year-end report to be submitted to the DepEd CDO and LGU-CDO.

Section 3. DepEd CDO shall:

- a. Recognize USTP as a satellite center/provider for ALS;
- b. Assign mobile teacher/s;
- c. Facilitate the enrolment of preferred target beneficiaries within the adapted communities and submit the certificate of enrollment after one month of the commencement of classes to LGU-CDO through the Office of the City Education and Development Officer-City Scholarships Office;
- d. Provide the mobile teacher with assistance in conducting the learning sessions;
- e. Facilitate the necessary orientation, capacity development, and guidelines for the ALS-NSP Teacher and ALS-NSP volunteer/pre-service teachers;
- f. Provide ALS learning resources and modules;
- g. Provide input on the direction, curriculum, and A&E examination schedule;
- h. Allow access to ALS documents such as curriculum, references, tools, and templates;
- i. Monitor the conduct of the ALS-NSP classes;
- j. Advise on the schedule of examinations required of the ALS-NSP learners; and
- k. Participate in the evaluation of the program.

ARTICLE III MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Section 4. No Employer-Employee Relationship. This MOA does not create an employer-employee relationship between and among LGU-CDO, USTP, and DepEd CDO, its officials and instructors, the NSP trainers, student-trainees, and, the other qualified applicants of the program.

Section 5. **Right to Revoke, Revise, Amend, or Rescind.** Either party may revoke, revise, amend, or rescind the MOA by notifying the other PARTY at least six (6) months prior to the graduation of the current batch. All parties shall ensure the orderly completion of ongoing programs.

Section 6. **Right to Renew**. This MOA is subject to review and renewal every three (3) years upon its effectivity

Section 7. **Confidentiality**. The Parties agree to keep all information and data exchanged or created under this MOA confidential and shall not be disclosed to anyone

unless expressly given consent by the data subject. The Parties agree to strictly observe the Data Privacy Act and be bound by the Data Sharing Agreement, herein attached as Annex "A", and made an integral part of this MOA.

Section 8. **Effectivity**. This agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing by all parties concerned and shall remain in force unless sooner terminated by mutual consent of the parties, in writing.

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Annex A —

DATA SHARING AGREEMENT

This **Data Sharing Agreement (DSA)** is entered into by and between the **CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO (LGU-CDO)** and **UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY OF SOUTHERN PHILIPPINES (USTP)** to establish the content, use, and protection of data provided between the Parties in relation to the implementation of the Alternative Learning System-Night School Program (ALS-NSP).

I. Term

This Agreement shall be in effect for three (3) years in accordance with the term of the Memorandum of Agreement to which this Data Sharing Agreement is made an integral part.

II. Intended Use of Data

The following are the intended uses of the shared data:

- a. Student Identification, control, verification and screening
- b. Grouping or classification
- c. Statistical processing
- d. Conducting research for improvement of students' learning

III. Limitations on the use of data

Data disclosed by the scholars/students to or collected on behalf of either Party is the property of the Collecting Party, and shall only be used for the above-stated purposes and shall not be shared with third parties without the written permission/consent of the First/Second Party, the City Government of Cagayan de Oro and data subject/s.

Such data shall not be sold or used, internally or externally, and for any other purpose not directly related to services provided by the Parties in this Agreement without the written permission of the First/Second Party, the City Government of Cagayan de Oro and data subject/s.

IV. Data Security

Both parties shall exercise at least the same degree of care it uses with its own personal data and confidential information, but in no event less than reasonable care, to protect the personal data from misuse and unauthorized access or disclosure. It shall adapt reasonable administrative, physical, and technical measures to prevent loss, misuse and alteration of the information under its control.

V. Data Elements

Personal information shared between the Parties shall be limited to the data elements specifically defined and authorized by each Party. If the other Party needs to collect additional data, its authorized personnel must submit a request in writing to the other Party. Under no circumstances shall any Party collect any information classified as

Sensitive or Confidential without the express written approval of the First/Second Party, the City Government of Cagayan de Oro and the data subject/s.

The data to be shared or collected shall be limited to the following elements:

- a. Scholar's/Student's Name (First Name, Middle Name/Initial, Last Name)
- b. Birthdate
- c. Age
- d. Gender
- e. Address
- f. COMELEC Registration
- g. Indigency Classification
- h. Contact Number and/or email address

Each party shall be responsible for securing consent from the patients to collect personal information and share these with the Other Party for referral purposes.

VI. Data Privacy Training

When there is an opportunity for the same, both Parties shall avail of any training for its personnel on internal security policies and procedures and on the Data Privacy Act, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and National Privacy Commission Issuances to protect personal data.

VII. Breach Management

a. *Report.* Within twenty-four (24) hours of becoming aware of the unauthorized use or disclosure of the personal data or any security incident or possible security breach, the concerned Party shall promptly report the fact to the other party who shared the personal data. Both parties, shall, within seventy-two (72) hours from such occurrence, notify the National Privacy Commission and the concerned data subject in accordance with NPC Circular 16-03.

b. Cooperation and Mitigation. Both parties shall cooperate with any mediation that is necessary to:

- 1. Address any applicable reporting requirements, and
- 2. Mitigate any effects of such unauthorized use or disclosure of personal data or any security incident or possible security breach.

VIII. Amendments and Alterations to this Agreement

Parties may amend this Agreement by mutual consent, in writing, at any time.

IX. Termination of Services

In the event that the MOA is terminated, the other Party shall return to the Collecting Party, all data collected in the course of the MOA.

FRANCISCO C. CANUTO, hereinafter referred to as the "FOUNDATION",

and

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, a local government unit ("LGU") existing under Philippine laws, through its OFFICE OF THE CITY EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICER, with office address at the Ground Floor, City Hall, Beside Police Station 1, Cagayan de Oro City, represented by its City Mayor **Hon. ROLANDO A. UY**, hereinafter referred to as "**CITY ED**".

(Each, a "Party", and collectively, the "Parties")

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, CITY ED, in its continuing concern for its constituents and commitment to assist in establishing a quality workforce, has developed scholarship programs for qualified students of Cagayan de Oro City;

WHEREAS, CITY ED has requested the FOUNDATION's support in the implementation of the scholarship programs;

WHEREAS, the FOUNDATION is an advocate of extending opportunities to economically-challenged but qualified and deserving students to enable them to obtain quality education;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of its advocacy, the FOUNDATION has agreed to provide financial assistance and/or benefits to qualified students under the scholarship programs of the CITY ED, subject to the terms and conditions indicated below;

WHEREAS, the FOUNDATION has agreed to set aside a mutually-agreed sum for the establishment and maintenance of a scholarship grant for grantees enrolled in Business, Engineering, IT, and Hotel and Restaurant Management degrees ("Qualified Degrees");

WHEREAS, the FOUNDATION and the CITY ED have agreed to collaborate to implement the aforesaid scholarship program in Cagayan de Oro City;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the terms and conditions indicated below, the Parties hereby agree to establish a scholarship program ("PROGRAM"), to provide financial assistance and/or benefits to economically- challenged but deserving and qualified students of Cagayan de Oro City ("SCHOLARS").

A. OBLIGATIONS OF THE FOUNDATION

The FOUNDATION shall:

- Provide financial assistance and/or benefits to, at most, ten (10) SCHOLARS meeting the qualifications in Part D, and following the selection process provided in this Agreement. The FOUNDATION shall determine the number of SCHOLARS to be supported by it from time to time in its sole reasonable discretion;
- Process the applications endorsed by CITY ED based on the qualifications and requirements stipulated herein, subject to the FOUNDATION's final screening and selection;

- Assist the endorsed applicants of CITY ED in accomplishing the FOUNDATION's online application portal and uploading the necessary requirements;
- Notify in writing the CITY ED of the names of the selected beneficiary SCHOLARS for the PROGRAM;
- Provide allowances per SCHOLAR in the amount of TWELVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php12,500.00) per semester, or TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (Php25,000.00) per academic year;
- Pay in full all official and duly-receipted school charges (tuition and miscellaneous fees only) for the relevant semester/term of the SCHOLAR. The payment for the school charges shall be deposited by the FOUNDATION to the trust fund account of CDO- CSO designated in writing. Late charges, installment interest, penalties, costs of school supplies and materials, and graduation fees are not included in the grant;
- Provide the financial grant to SCHOLARS enrolled in any of the following partner schools:
 - Liceo de Cagayan University
 - Lourdes College
 - Phinma Cagayan De Oro College
 - STI College;
- 8. Assist the SCHOLARS in opening bank accounts with Unionbank of the Philippines, through which the financial assistance provided by the FOUNDATION shall be deposited;
- Give, transfer and convey to CITY ED the payment for the tuition and miscellaneous fees of the SCHOLARS every start of the semester through its designated trust fund account; and
- 10. Coordinate with CITY ED in monitoring the implementation of the PROGRAM.

B. OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY ED

CITY ED shall:

- Take charge in promoting the PROGRAM and allow the FOUNDATION to post information regarding the PROGRAM, or any other programs or activities of the FOUNDATION or any of its affiliates as may be requested by the FOUNDATION, in print, radio, television, and other media, subject to the approval of both Parties as to the contents thereof, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed;
- Create a selection or screening committee tasked to process and evaluate the applications for the PROGRAM;
- Accept applications and conduct pre-screening procedures consisting of, but not limited to, interviews of the applicants to determine their qualifications, based on the requirements provided in Parts D and E;
- Endorse pre-qualified applications for inclusion to the PROGRAM through a letter to the FOUNDATION, and provide the FOUNDATION with copies of all application documents submitted to or secured by CITY ED;
- Upon written acceptance of the FOUNDATION, notify the SCHOLARS concerned of their admission to the PROGRAM, the terms and conditions thereof, their duties and responsibilities, and the limits of the grant of the allowances and financial assistance to the SCHOLARS as provided in Parts A.5 and A.6;
- Inform the FOUNDATION of any SCHOLARS withdrawing from the PROGRAM and/or not meeting the qualifications provided herein, and recommend qualified applicant(s) to fill-in the available stot(s);
- Submit to the FOUNDATION copies of the SCHOLAR's application documents, current school registration card and scholastic records;
- Furnish the FOUNDATION a status report of scholastic records one week after the end of each school term;
- Include the SCHOLARS in all of CITY ED's relevant activities and programs in order to foster their holistic development;
- 10. Keep separate records of the PROGRAM for future assessment;
- 11. Ensure the efficient administration of the PROGRAM, and promptly report to the FOUNDATION any issues or concerns regarding the implementation of the PROGRAM;
- 12. Provide such information, documents and certifications relating to the PROGRAM, as

may be requested by the FOUNDATION from time to time;

- 13. Be responsible for the notarization and other fees (if any) relating to the execution of the MOA;
- 14. Notify the FOUNDATION in writing, the total amount of the tuition and miscellaneous fees to be shouldered by the FOUNDATION, and attach to such notification the official documents from the schools in support of the fees and other relevant documents (e.g., billing statement, course curriculum/syllabus);
- 15. Upon receipt from the FOUNDATION of the payment for the tuition and miscellaneous fees of the SCHOLARS, provide the FOUNDATION with a confirmation receipt for the payment deposited to the designated trust fund;
- 16. Provide the FOUNDATION with the official receipts from the schools evidencing the payment of the tuition and miscellaneous fees not later than five (5) days from payment thereof, as well as other relevant documents (e.g., Certificate of Enrollment of the SCHOLARS); and
- 17. Execute and provide the FOUNDATION with all relevant documents and/or assist the FOUNDATION in securing all the needed documents from the schools and/or SCHOLARS, as the case may be, in order to give full effect to the donation granted by the FOUNDATION of the amount comprising the tuition and miscellaneous fees and allowances for each SCHOLAR.

C. CONFIDENTIALITY AND INFORMATION SECURITY

- 1. The Parties agree to protect the confidentiality of each other's Confidential Information in the same manner as they protect the confidentiality of their own Confidential Information of like kind, but in no event shall either Party use less than reasonable care. Each Party shall not disclose to, or use for its own benefit, or permit the use by its employees or representatives, or by any third party for its benefit, any Confidential Information disclosed to it or acquired by it in performance of this Agreement, except to each Party's personnel who need to know the same and who have agreed in writing to abide by the terms of this Agreement.
- The Parties shall take all necessary precautions to prevent any unauthorized disclosure or use of Confidential Information by any of its employees, agents, representatives, or third parties.
- 3. CITY ED shall not create copies, reproduce, duplicate, scan, or print any digital or hard copy of any Confidential Information, without the prior written consent of the FOUNDATION. In addition, CITY ED shall secure the prior written consent of the applicants and SCHOLARS with respect to the transmission of their application documents and scholastic records to the FOUNDATION, and the FOUNDATION's further processing thereof in connection with the implementation of the PROGRAM. Copies of such written consent shall be furnished by CITY ED to the FOUNDATION.
- 4. Pursuant to this Part C, the term "Confidential Information" shall refer to all non-public, sensitive or proprietary business and technical information or data, which either Party may have furnished the other Party, or otherwise acquired by such other Party, in connection with this Agreement, whether orally, visually, electronically or in writing, and regardless of whether such information or data is marked as "confidential" or other equivalent legend. "Confidential Information" does not include any particular information that the receiving Party can demonstrate: (a) was rightfully in the possession of or known by the receiving Party without an obligation to maintain its confidentiality prior to receipt from the disclosing Party; (b) was or has become generally available to the public other than as a result of disclosure by the receiving Party; (c) was received from a third party who, to the receiving Party's knowledge, had a lawful right to disclose such information to the receiving Party without any obligation to restrict its further use or disclosure; (d) was independently developed by the receiving Party without use of or reference to any Confidential Information of the disclosing Party; or (e) required by law or order of a government authority to be disclosed, provided that prompt written notice of such legally-compelled disclosure is provided to the disclosing Party to allow the latter to waive the confidentiality obligations herein or otherwise secure a protective order against the disclosure.

5. The Parties agree to comply with the provisions of Republic Act No. 10173 or the Data Privacy Act of 2012, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and all other rules and regulations relevant to data privacy and the protection of personal information obtained, acquired or processed under this Agreement. In this regard, the Parties agree to be bound by the Data Sharing Agreement, herein attached as Annex "A", made an integral part of this MOA.

D. QUALIFICATIONS FOR SCHOLARS

A student applying for inclusion to the PROGRAM must possess all the qualifications indicated below, as substantiated by the required supporting documents:

- 1. Must be a Filipino Citizen;
- 2. Must be a bona fide college student residing in Cagayan de Oro City and enrolled in any of the Qualified Degrees in any year level;
- 3. If an incoming Freshman student, he/she must have a General Weighted Average of 85% or higher;
- 4. If an incoming 2nd, 3rd or 4th year college student, he/she must maintain a General Weighted Average of 85% per semester;
- 5. Must carry the regular load prescribed in the curriculum;
- 6. Must not have a failing grade (5.0 or equivalent), incomplete, dropped, or withdraw as a final grade;
- 7. Must not shift to another course or transfer to another school;
- 8. Must pass the initial interview by the CITY ED, and final interview conducted by the FOUNDATION;
- Must belong to a family whose joint family income is not higher than THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (Php300,000.00) per annum as stated in the income tax return ("ITR"), "Affidavit for Non-Filing of Income Tax" or "BIR Certification for Tax Exempt" of the applicant's parents/guardian;
- 10. Must not be a recipient of any other scholarships.

It is understood that the qualifications provided below are continuing requirements, and a SCHOLAR may be disqualified from receiving benefits under the PROGRAM if he/she fails to satisfy all the aforesaid qualifications. CITY ED shall ensure that the SCHOLARS are aware of these conditions for admission to the PROGRAM.

E. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

An applicant must submit two (2) copies of the following:

- 1. Photocopy of Birth Certificate
- 2. Photocopy of Form 137 or Official Final Grade;
- 3. Photocopy of Current School Registration Card;
- 4. Photocopy of Parents' or Guardian's Income Tax Return ("ITR") or Certificate of Non-Filing of ITR or BIR Certification for Tax Exempt;
- 5. House Photos;
- 6. Family Photo; and
- 7. Accomplished Application Form.

F. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SCHOLARS

CITY ED shall ensure that the SCHOLARS admitted to the PROGRAM are aware of, and comply with, the following responsibilities:

- 1. Assist CITY ED and the FOUNDATION in promoting the PROGRAM;
- Communicate regularly with the FOUNDATION'S Scholarship Coordinator on his/her academic performance;
- 3. After graduation, assist the FOUNDATION in future activities related to the PROGRAM; and
- 4. Provide updates on personal contact information and other details to the FOUNDATION and CITY ED, in order for the SCHOLARS to be contacted concerning activities

regarding the PROGRAM.

Upon graduation, SCHOLARS are encouraged to apply for employment with the following companies under the Alliance Global Group ("AGI Companies"), subject to meeting the standard employment procedures set by the relevant companies and manpower requirements:

- Emperador Distillers, Inc.
- Empire East Land Holdings, Inc.
- Global-Estate Resorts, Inc.
- Global One Integrated Business Service, Inc.
- McDonald's Philippines
- Megaworld Corporation
- Suntrust Properties, Inc.
- Travellers International Hotel Group, Inc.

For the avoidance of doubt, it is hereby agreed that the FOUNDATION and the AGI Companies have no obligation to employ the SCHOLARS upon their graduation. CITY ED is likewise prohibited from making such representations to any SCHOLARS.

G. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PROGRAM

- 1. The SCHOLARS must be enrolled in the regular number of units/load as prescribed in the curriculum of each school, until the completion of the course.
- 2. The SCHOLARS must not drop, repeat or withdraw from any subject.
- SCHOLARS who are accepted to the PROGRAM must maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at 85%, and must not have any failing marks "5.0" (or its equivalent), "INC" or "W".
- 4. Enrolment registration should be submitted every school term. Deferment of enrolment shall not be allowed.
- 5. Transferring to another school or shifting to another course is strictly prohibited.
- Disbursement of financial assistance shall be processed only upon the submission of the following requirements:
 - Endorsement letter from CITY ED;
 - Current School Registration Form;
 - School's Official Report of Grades; and
 - Updated Course Curriculum / Syllabus.
- 7. The following are the non-exclusive grounds to terminate the grant of financial assistance to a SCHOLAR and disqualify him/her from the PROGRAM:
 - Failure to meet the grade requirement
 - Failure to meet the qualifications provided in Part D
 - Shifting to another course or transferring of school
 - Deferment of enrolment
 - Violation of school policies
 - Disciplinary procedure is conducted against the SCHOLAR
 - Concealment of a material fact or misrepresentation of qualifications during application
 - Availment of other scholarship programs
- 8. The Parties shall formulate the procedure to be followed in the event that grounds exist to disqualify a SCHOLAR from the PROGRAM, and ensure that due process is provided to the SCHOLAR. CITY ED and the FOUNDATION shall decide on a case- by-case basis if grounds warrant the termination of the scholarship. In case of disagreement, the FOUNDATION's decision shall prevail.

H. EXECUTION OF DEED OF DONATION AND ACCEPTANCE

Upon selection of the qualified SCHOLARS under the PROGRAM and disbursement of PROGRAM funds, the FOUNDATION and the SCHOLAR, with the assistance of CITY ED, shall execute a Deed of Donation and Acceptance, the template of which is attached hereto as Annex "B", to formally document the intention of the FOUNDATION to donate its funds to finance the tuition, miscellaneous fees and allowances of the SCHOLAR, and the SCHOLAR's acceptance of the donated funds.

I. TERM AND TERMINATION

The **PROGRAM** shall have a duration of one (1) year commencing on the First Semester of the Academic Year 2024-2025. The **PROGRAM** may be extended upon mutual written agreement of the Parties.

Each Party reserves the right to terminate the **PROGRAM** at any time, upon sixty (60) days' written notice to the other Party, provided, that the existing **SCHOLARS** at the time of termination shall continue to receive the benefits they are currently enjoying under the **PROGRAM** until the end of the semester during which the termination has occurred, unless they have been disqualified from the **PROGRAM** for failure to meet the retention requirements cited herein.

J. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Relationship between the Parties. The Parties acknowledge that there is no agency, employer-employee, partnership or joint-venture arrangement created by virtue of this Agreement. CITY ED or its personnel assigned to the PROGRAM are not agents or employees of the FOUNDATION and shall not represent themselves as agents or employees of the FOUNDATION. CITY ED or its personnel shall have no authority to bind the FOUNDATION to any contract or arrangement with any third party, or incur any financial obligation, for and on behalf of the FOUNDATION, except as explicitly provided in this Agreement.
- 2. Amendment. The Parties may, upon mutual written consent, amend or modify this Agreement any time by or through an addendum signed by the Parties, which addendum shall form an integral part of this Agreement.
- 3. Annual Review. This Agreement and the PROGRAM shall be reviewed by the Parties on an annual basis.
- 4. Notices. All notices, requests, consents and other documents required under this Agreement shall be given/served either by personal delivery, in writing, by fax, through email or registered mail, or sent through reputable courier services with return receipt requested, and postage prepaid properly addressed to the Party or its designated agent/representative. Notices shall be addressed as follows:

- 5. Dispute Resolution. In case of dispute between the Parties arising out of or relating to this Agreement, the Parties agree to exert efforts to amicably settle the same. Failing at which, the dispute shall be brought for resolution by the proper courts of Cagayan de Oro City, to the exclusion of all other venues.
- 6. Approvals. The Parties represent and warrant that all consents, approvals and authorizations necessary for the due execution, delivery, performance or enforceability of the Agreement have been obtained, and are in full force and effect.
- 7. Waiver. A waiver by either Party of a breach or failure to perform the provisions of the Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach or failure. No waiver shall be deemed valid unless made in writing and signed by the Party waiving its right.
- 8. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

ANNEX "A"

DATA SHARING AGREEMENT

This **Data Sharing Agreement (DSA)** is entered into by and between the **CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO (LGU-CDO)**, and **MEGAWORLD FOUNDATION**, **INC.** to establish the content, use, and protection of data provided between the Parties in relation to the implementation of the City Scholarship Program.

i. Term

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This Agreement shall be in effect for one (1) year in accordance with the term of the Memorandum of Agreement to which this Data Sharing Agreement is made an integral part.

II. Intended Use of Data

The following are the intended uses of the shared data:

- a. Student Identification, control and verification
- b. Grouping or classification
- c. Statistical processing
- d. Conducting research for improvement of students' learning

III. Limitations on the use of data

Data disclosed by the scholars/students to or collected on behalf of either Party is the property of the Collecting Party, and shall only be used for the above-stated purposes and shall not be shared with third parties without the written permission/consent of the First/Second Party, the City Government of Cagayan de Oro and data subject/s.

Such data shall not be sold or used, internally or externally, and for any other purpose not directly related to services provided by the Parties in this Agreement without the written permission of the First/Second Party, the City Government of Cagayan de Oro and data subject/s.

IV. Data Security

Both parties shall exercise at least the same degree of care it uses with its own personal data and confidential information, but in no event less than reasonable care, to protect the personal data from misuse and unauthorized access or disclosure. It shall adapt reasonable administrative, physical, and technical measures to prevent loss, misuse and alteration of the information under its control.

V. Data Elements

Personal information shared between the Parties shall be limited to the data elements specifically defined and authorized by each Party. If the other Party needs to collect additional data, its authorized personnel must submit a request in writing to the other Party. Under no circumstances shall any Party collect any information classified as Sensitive or Confidential without the express written approval of the First/Second Party, the City Government of Cagayan de Oro and the data subject/s.

The data to be shared or collected shall be limited to the following elements:

- 1. Scholar's/Student's Name (First Name, Middle Name/Initial, Last Name)
- 2. Birthdate
- 3. Age
- 4. Gender
- 5. Address
- 6. COMELEC Registration
- 7. Indigency Classification
- 8. Contact Number and/or email address

Each party shall be responsible for securing consent from the patients to collect personal information and share these with the Other Party for referral purposes.

VI. Data Privacy Training

When there is an opportunity for the same, both Parties shall avail of any training for its personnel on internal security policies and procedures and on the Data Privacy Act, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and National Privacy Commission Issuances to protect personal data.

VII. Breach Management

a. *Report.* Within twenty-four (24) hours of becoming aware of the unauthorized use or disclosure of the personal data or any security incident or possible security breach, the concerned Party shall promptly report the fact to the other party who shared the personal data. Both parties, shall, within seventy-two (72) hours from such occurrence, notify the National Privacy Commission and the concerned data subject in accordance with NPC Circular 16-03.

b. Cooperation and Mitigation. Both parties shall cooperate with any mediation that is necessary to:

- 1. Address any applicable reporting requirements, and
- 2. Mitigate any effects of such unauthorized use or disclosure of personal data or any security incident or possible security breach.

VIII. Amendments and Alterations to this Agreement

Parties may amend this Agreement by mutual consent, in writing, at any time.

IX. Termination of Services

In the event that the MOA is terminated, the other Party shall return to the Collecting Party, all data collected in the course of the MOA.
