Revised Guidelines on the Naming and Renaming of Streets, Public Schools, Plazas, Building, Bridges and other Public Structures

Revised Guidelines on the Naming and Renaming of Streets, Public Schools, Plazas, Building, Bridges and other Public Structures

I. Who May Name or Rename

1. All public places may be named or renamed by the President, through a proclamation, or by Congress, through legislation.

1.a. Local government units can not rename public place if the original name was created by an act of Congress or by a proclamation of the President of the Philippines;

1.b. No national road, school, hospital and other national property can be named or renamed by a local government unit.

2. Public places under the jurisdiction of the local governments with the exception of barangays may be named or renamed by the local government unit concerned (e.g. a provincial road cannot be renamed by a municipal or city government)

2.a. The change of name of any local government unit shall be effective only upon ratification in a plebiscite conducted for the purpose in the political unit directly affected. (Letter "f" of Sec. 13 of Local Government Code)

3. The sanggunians of component cities and municipalities may, in consultation with the National Historical Institute, change the name of streets, roads, schools, health facilities or any other public place or building within its territorial jurisdiction (see "c" Sec. 13 of Local Government Code)

4. Renaming of a public school shall be made only upon the recommendation of the local school board concerned, while those of public hospitals, health centers, and other health facilities shall be made only upon the recommendation of the local health board concerned (Letters "e" and "f" of Section 13 of Local Government Code)

II. What May Be Renamed

1. Present names of provinces, cities, towns and barangays may be renamed provided that the renaming shall be a reversion to their old names, found to be more culturally and historically significant.

2. National roads, schools, bridges, buildings, plazas and other structures can be renamed by the Office of the President or the Congress of the Philippines.

3. Public roads, schools, bridges, buildings and other structures under the jurisdiction of the local governments may be renamed by the local government unit concerned;

III. Character of Names

1. Proposed names must have historical and cultural significance and must contribute to the positive development of national pride through the good example exhibited by the name being used.
2. Recommended names for public places should be appropriate in terms of historical value and significance to the place to be named or renamed.
3. Indigenous names of roads, streets, barangays and other places should always be preserved especially if that name is unique to the place. (e.g. places named Sampaguita, Tagaytay, Kundiman, Tayuman, etc., should not be renamed).
4. Hispanized and foreign terms should be retained if they have attained a degree of historical significance and have been sanctified by usage.
5. The use of Filipino words should be encouraged in the naming or renaming of streets, plazas and other public places.
6. Names should be short and simple for practical and aesthetic reasons. However, the use of nicknames or aliases in the naming of public places should be discouraged.
7. The use of names which are complicated and confusing shall be discouraged. In cases where the name and initials are the same with other prominent personages, the full name of the person intended to be honored should be specified.
8. *Schools, hospitals and other public structures named after the province or municipality are considered appropriately named and, therefore, shall not be renamed. **
9. The old name, of streets, schools, hospitals, etc., which have been sanctified by usage by the residents of the community, should be placed underneath the new name in the signage to facilitate the delivery of postal matter and serve as direct guide for people accustomed to the former names.
10. *Natural features such as islands, rivers, seas, oceans, mountains, plains shall not be renamed, unless there are being reverted to their old indigenous names. **

IV. Naming/Renaming after Persons

1. Street, plaza or any public place may be named or renamed to honor a person or family who contributed to the welfare of the Filipino people.
2. Streets bearing the names of religious personalities identified with the national movement should be retained or recommended for street names as well as for other public places.

3. Public places such as those already named after presidents, national heroes cannot be replaced with names of people of lesser importance. (e.g. places named after national heroes cannot be renamed after local heroes; places named after Presidents cannot be renamed after Senators);

4. No local government units, institutions, places or buildings shall be named or renamed after a living person.

5. **Roads can be named/renamed after the following:***

- a. **Presidents and national heroes for primary roads;**
- b. **Senators and congressmen for secondary roads; and**
- c. **Local officials for tertiary roads**

6. No public place should be named or renamed after a person within ten (10) years of his death **except for highly exceptional reasons** (e.g. his death was due to assassination in the service of the country, he/she gave exceptional service to the nation, death while trying to save others, death was a result of his patriotism, and death while in performance of one's duty).

7. A change of name cannot be made unless for a justifiable reason and, in any case, not oftener than once every ten (10) years. (see letter "d" of Sec. 13 of Local Government Code)

8. In the naming of public places after people, the use of the word "memorial" should be deleted as it is already understood that the person being honored is already deceased.

9. Honorific titles like "Don," "Doña," etc., should be deleted in naming or renaming of streets, plazas and other public places for aesthetic and practical reasons.

10. To avoid confusion in the maintenance of records and delivery of postal matters the former name of the public place must always be recommended to be placed ~~beneath the new name in the signage.~~

11. No public place should be named or renamed after a person when questionable propriety might arise from the said act.

IV. Historical Significance

1. No public place should be renamed if the present name has attained a degree of historical association and has developed an importance of its own.

2. Names of places, which have been sanctified by long usage by the people, shall be retained and preserved.

3. Names of public places named after foreigners or places with foreign names may be retained if these names were associated with the place and attained a degree of historical significance.

V. Aesthetic Unity

1. No street or road should be renamed if it is one of complex of related street names in one district and renaming one of them would destroy aesthetic unity.

VI. Continuity

1. No portion of a street or road may be renamed if it would tend to disrupt the continuity of its present name.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and their mutual covenants, the **PARTIES** hereby agree as follows:

I. ROLES/RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FIRST PARTY

2. Release the BSP City Aid quarterly in the name of BSP-CDO Council upon the signing of the MOA, subject to the standard government accounting and auditing and regulations.

II. ROLES/RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY

1. Receive and issue the corresponding official receipt of the BSP City Aid in accordance with the standard government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
2. Ensure proper accounting for the disbursement of the BSP City Aid, which is intended exclusively for the above-mentioned purposes;
3. Submit to the FIRST PARTY, if necessary or required, the accomplishment report detailing the undertakings of the BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES;
4. Be responsible for the liquidation of funds upon the completion of each activity or event; and
5. Be responsible/accountable for returning any unutilized amounts in completing the project/s, including interest, if applicable.

III. EFFECTIVITY

This MOA shall take effect upon the date of signing of BOTH PARTIES and shall remain valid until the completion thereof.

IV. GENERAL

1. The PARTIES shall endeavor to resolve any disagreement arising from or in connection with this Agreement, in an amicable manner by direct informal negotiation. 2. It is hereby expressly agreed by the PARTIES that the venue of any court action/litigation by virtue of any breach/violation of the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be at Cagayan de Oro City only, to the exclusion of all other courts;
3. If any part, provision, representation, or warranty of this Agreement shall be prohibited or held to be void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain valid and be given full force and effect.
4. The terms of this Agreement shall be interpreted according to the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is entered into by and between:

The CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY GOVERNMENT, a local government unit duly created and existing under Philippine laws with principal office address at City Hall Compound, 89 Capistrano-Hayes Sts., Cagayan De Oro City, represented in this act by its City Mayor, HON. ROLANDO A. UY, hereinafter referred to as the "LGU";

-and-

JOLLIBEE FOODS CORPORATION, a corporation duly organized and existing under Philippine laws with address at 10/F Jollibee Plaza Building, 10 F. Ortigas Jr. Avenue, Ortigas Center, Pasig City, represented herein by its President, FERNANDO S. YU, JR., hereinafter referred to as "COMPANY".

(Each a "Party" and collectively, "Parties.")

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Article XIII, Section 11 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable costs, prioritizing the needs of the underprivileged sick, elderly, disabled, women and children;

WHEREAS, the above policy of the Constitution treats the elderly and the differently abled as similarly situated in terms of being afforded essential goods, health, and other social services relevant to their needs;

WHEREAS, the LGU recognizes the invaluable role of the elderly and the differently abled in the development of the city given the opportunity to be productive members of the society;

WHEREAS, the COMPANY recognizes the LGU's assistance to the elderly and the differently abled who have the capacity and desire to work, or be re-employed, to be in line with its own corporate social responsibility towards the elderly and the differently abled;

WHEREAS, in support of the LGU, the COMPANY intends to open its facilities to accommodate qualified elderly and differently abled individuals for temporary employment ("Program");

NOW, THEREFORE, the LGU and the COMPANY, finding a commonality of cause to advance the interest of the elderly and the differently abled, hereby enter into this covenant, subject to the following terms and conditions, to wit:

1. In order to qualify for temporary employment, the elderly or the differently-abled individual must possess the following qualifications:

A. For the elderly or senior citizens:

- i. Must be sixty (60) years of age and above at the time of application;
- ii. Must pass the physical, medical, and laboratory examinations, and certified to be FIT TO WORK;
- iii. Must have the capacity to perform the functions to be assigned by COMPANY; and
- iv. Must submit the following documents to the COMPANY:
 - a. Recommendation from the Public Employment Services Office;
 - b. Resume;
 - c. Medical Certification, indicating, FIT TO WORK;
 - d. Results of the physical, medical, and laboratory examinations;
 - e. Mayor's Permit (Occupational Permit) to be issued by the City Health Office of the LGU;
 - f. Barangay Certification;
 - g. Police Clearance or NBI Clearance; and
 - h. Birth Certificate, or other competent proofs of identity, including Senior Citizen's Identification Card.

B. For differently abled or persons with disabilities:

- i. The individual must be a Deaf and Mute (subject to subsequent inclusion of other differently abled individuals);
- ii. Must pass the physical, medical, and laboratory examinations, and certified to be FIT TO WORK;
- iii. Must have the capacity to perform the functions to be assigned by COMPANY; and
- iv. Must submit the following documents to the COMPANY:
 - a. Recommendation from the Public Employment Services Office;
 - b. Resume;
 - c. Medical Certification, indicating, FIT TO WORK;
 - d. Results of the physical, medical, and laboratory examinations;
 - e. Mayor's Permit (Occupational Permit) to be issued by the City Health Office of the LGU
 - f. Barangay Certification;

 - h. Birth Certificate, or other competent proofs of identity, including Senior Citizen's Identification Card;

- C. Collectively, senior citizens or elderly individuals, and persons with disabilities or differently able individuals, shall hereinafter be referred to as APPLICANT/S;

2. The LGU undertakes to comply with the following duties and responsibilities through its appropriate offices, namely;

A. The Public Employment Services Office shall:

- i. Receive applicants into the program
- ii. Conduct initial interview and profiling;
- iii. Prepare the Recommendation Letter to undergo examination, addressed to the City Health Officer, requesting that the bearer-applicant be subjected to physical, medical, and laboratory examinations;
- iv. Prepare, on behalf of the applicant, a Conforme, to be executed by the applicant and notarized by a commissioned notary public, consenting to the conduct of examinations to be administered by the City Health Office.
- v. Explain to the applicant the consequences of failing in any of the qualifications required in order to avail themselves of the benefit of the program ;
- vi. Provide training facilities to qualified applicants prior to deployment to the COMPANY branch;
- vii. Cover the expenses relative to the conduct of training programs for qualified applicants;

B. The City Health Office shall:

- i. Serve as the official/ accredited medical institution to conduct physical, medical, and laboratory examination of applicants vying for temporary employment with the COMPANY;
- ii. Prior to the conduct of the examination of applicants, receive the Recommendation Letter to undergo examination from the Public Employment Services Office;
- iii. Conduct the examination in two (2) phases, namely:
 - a. **1st TEST - Physical and Medical Examination.** The purpose of which is to determine the physical capacity of the applicant to discharge the minimum physical requirements of the tasks to be complied with and the existence of any medical condition that may or may not affect the discharge of such tasks;
 - b. **2nd TEST - Laboratory Examination.** This covers the conduct of Hepatitis B Screening, Drug Testing, ECG Test, and Chest X-Ray;
 - c. Should the applicant pass the said tests, a Certification indicating **FIT TO WORK** shall be issued and the applicant will be directed to return to the Public Employment Service Office. Otherwise, the applicant shall be issued a Certification indicating **NOT FIT TO WORK** and shall be directed, instead, to proceed to the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) for debriefing;
- iv. Submit daily reports to the Public Employment Service Office of the applicants issued **FIT / NOT FIT TO WORK** Certifications;
- v. Facilitate the issuance of the Mayor's (Occupational) Permit in favor of qualified applicants that have been certified **FIT TO WORK**;

- C. The CSWDO and the Office of the Senior Citizen's Affairs shall:
- i. Be responsible for the information dissemination of the program to the prospective elderly (Office of the Senior Citizen's Affairs) or differently abled (Cagayan de Oro City Department of Social Welfare) applicants;
 - ii. Conduct debriefing sessions for applicants who failed to qualify for the program or whose temporary employment was pre-terminated with cause; and
 - iii. Undertake to provide trainers to assist and instruct qualified applicants prior to deployment to the COMPANY branch;
3. The COMPANY undertakes to comply with the following duties and responsibilities:
- A. The COMPANY shall hire a minimum of ____ qualified applicants under the program, ____ senior citizens or elderly individuals and ____ persons with disability or differently abled individual;
 - B. The COMPANY shall create programs within their respective branches suited for the qualified applicants. The said programs shall be submitted to the Public Employment Service Office and the Department of Labor and Employment;
 - C. The COMPANY shall receive the documentary requirements from the qualified applicant, namely:
 - i. Recommendation from the Public Employment Services Office;
 - ii. Resume;
 - iii. Medical Certification, indicating, FIT TO WORK;
 - iv. Results of the physical, medical, and laboratory examinations;
 - v. Mayor's Permit (Occupational Permit) to be issued by the City Health Office;
 - vi. Barangay Certification;
 - vii. Police Clearance or NBI Clearance; and
 - viii. Birth Certificate, or other competent proofs of identity, including Senior Citizen's Identification Card;
 - D. The COMPANY shall conduct interview, orientation, trainings, and minimal examinations to the qualified applicant;
 - E. The COMPANY shall integrate the qualified applicants, upon submission of the requirements, into their workforce, subject to the following conditions:
 - i. For senior citizens or elderly individuals, they shall be assigned to work for not more than four (4) hours a day, in shifts between 8:00 am to 12:00 noon or 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm, for five (5) days a week;
 - ii. For persons with disabilities or differently abled individuals, they may be assigned to work in shifts not to exceed eight (8) hours a day excluding meal breaks;
 - iii. Qualified applicants shall be stationed in the lobby area only and shall perform the following tasks:

- a. Order Presentors;
 - b. Drink Drawers;
 - c. Table Managers;
 - d. Guest Relations Staff;
- iv. The qualified applicants to the Program shall be entitled to pro-rated compensation equal to the prevailing minimum wage and such compensation shall be adjusted for as often as new minimum wage rates are implemented;
 - v. The qualified applicants to the Program shall be entitled to receive a pro-rated thirteenth (13th) month pay.
 - vi. The qualified applicants shall be included in the group medical insurance to be secured by the COMPANY;
 - vii. The duration of the temporary employment shall not exceed a period of six (6) months or one hundred eighty (180) days;
- F. The COMPANY shall facilitate the opening of payroll bank accounts for the qualified applicants, free from any and all charges that banks and other financial institutions may impose;
 - G. The COMPANY shall submit periodic reports to the Public Employment Service Office of the hired qualified applicants, those not hired, and the reason for the non-hiring;
4. The qualified applicant engaged by the COMPANY shall be obliged:
 - A. Prior to being engaged by the COMPANY, to undergo trainings and enter into an appropriate contract with the COMPANY;
 - B. To abide by the rules and regulations imposed by the COMPANY to its own regular employees; and
 - C. To perform tasks in accordance with the reasonable instructions from the COMPANY or its authorized representative.
 5. The temporary employment of senior citizens or elderly individuals, and persons with disabilities or differently able individuals, however would not give rise to employer-employee relationship between the former and the LGU.
 6. Except as to the fitness to work of the senior citizens or elderly and persons with disabilities or differently able, the LGU assumes no liability for death or injuries suffered arising from the employment of the senior citizens or elderly and persons with disabilities or differently able under this Agreement after the conduct of necessary medical examination and issuance of Medical Certification, indicating, FIT TO WORK;
 7. This Agreement and all documents and information provided by one Party to the other Party under, or in connection with the negotiation of this Agreement or any subsequent contractual undertakings shall be treated as Confidential Information. The Confidential Information shall not be used except for the purpose of implementing the Program and the purposes for which it was made available, and shall not be disclosed to any other person without the prior written consent of the disclosing Party. Each Party agrees that it will take all reasonable measures to protect the secrecy of, and avoid disclosure or use of Confidential Information of the other Party in order to prevent such from falling into the public domain or the

possession of persons other than those persons authorized herein to have access to such information. Such reasonable measures shall include the highest degree of care that the receiving Party utilizes to protect its own confidential information of a similar nature, which shall be no less than reasonable care. Each Party agrees, upon reasonable request, to inform the other Party of the details of the security measures established to protect the other Party's Confidential Information. Each Party will ensure compliance with this Agreement by such Party's employees, representatives and advisors, and the qualified applicants.

8. This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the Parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof and cancels, supersedes or otherwise nullifies any prior oral or written Agreements with respect hereto.
9. Any and all amendments and modifications to this Agreement shall be in writing and signed by all the Parties hereto.
10. LGU-CDOC and JOLLIBEE CORP. shall not be liable to qualified elderly and differently abled individuals of the employment program for any loss, injury, delay, damages or other casualty suffered or incurred due to strikes, riots, storms, fires, explosions, acts of God, war, coup d'état, action of any government or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the party (each, a Force Majeure Event), and any failure or delay by any Party in performing any of its obligations under this Agreement
11. The Parties acknowledge that they have agreed amongst each other in good faith and at arms length with respect to the terms, conditions and provisions hereof, that each Party has determined for himself or herself that this Agreement is fair and reasonable, and that the words and phrases in this Agreement express the true intentions of all the Parties so that no rule of strict construction should be applied when interpreting and construing this Agreement.

Dear Ma'am:

This is in response to the proposal of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered by and between the Local Government Unit of Cagayan de Oro City, (LGU-CDOC) through the City Social Welfare and Development (CSWD) and Jollibee Foods Corporation represented by FERNANDO S. YU, JR. PERTAINING TO Jollibee's intention to open its facilities in accommodating qualified elderly and differently abled individuals for temporary employment program.

In view thereof, this office recommends that the venue *shall not be included* in the provisions of the MOA in consideration that the parties are amenable to settle all matters of conflict thru an arbitration. Be it noted in the letter dated July 2, 2024, specifically on the 2nd legal recommendation, to quote:

Second, in case of disagreements or breach to the contract, the parties shall earnestly give its effort to *arbitrate the unsettled matter*. This is in consideration of the unified cause of the parties in setting forth this project, the invaluable role of the elderly and the differently abled to be productive members of the society. Thus, it is hereby recommended that Item No. 8 be changed into an arbitration clause, as follows:

"Any dispute, controversy, difference or claim arising out of or in relation to this agreement, including any question as to the interpretation, implementation, existence, validity, breach or termination thereof or as to any non-contractual obligation arising out of or relating thereto, shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration Rules in force at the time of the commencement of the arbitration, which rules are deemed incorporated by reference in this clause.

If the aforesaid second legal recommendation is not viable, let be the venue of the filing of the case of any suit arising from the agreement be in Cagayan de Oro, Philippines.

Since both parties are viable to arbitration clause, let the venue be not included.

Instead, this office conveys its intent that both parties, LGU-CDOC and JOLLIBEE CORP. shall be completely absolved from all or any actions of suits and liabilities.

The following provision mentioned below is the proposed draft of the aforesaid provision and to be added in the MOA, as follows:

LEGAL ACTION

LGU-CDOC and JOLLIBEE CORP. shall not be held liable for the independent acts or omissions of the qualified elderly and differently abled individuals for the employment program.

Independent acts or omissions mean those acts and omissions done outside the work hours of the of the qualified elderly and differently abled individuals for the employment program including but not limited to those committed in events which are held outside employment premises. These actions and omissions comprise of conduct that are outside the scope of the qualified elderly and differently abled individual's duties and responsibilities.

In the event of any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or for any breach, termination, or invalidity thereof, the Parties are mandated to settle the same through mediation.

In addition, the following terms/provisions are advised to be included in the MOA:

ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the Parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof and cancels, supersedes or otherwise nullifies any prior oral or written Agreements with respect hereto.

MODIFICATIONS

Any and all amendments and modifications to this Agreement shall be in writing and signed by all the Parties hereto.

FORCE MAJEURE

LGU-CDOC and JOLLIBEE CORP. shall not be liable to qualified elderly and differently abled individuals of the employment program for any loss, injury, delay, damages or other casualty suffered or incurred due to strikes, riots, storms, fires, explosions, acts of God, war, coup d'état, action of any government or any other



cause beyond the reasonable control of the party (each, a Force Majeure Event), and any failure or delay by any Party in performing any of its obligations under this Agreement

NO STRICT CONSTRUCTION

The Parties acknowledge that they have agreed amongst each other in good faith and at arms length with respect to the terms, conditions and provisions hereof, that each Party has determined for himself or herself that this Agreement is fair and reasonable, and that the words and phrases in this Agreement express the true intentions of all the Parties so that no rule of strict construction should be applied when interpreting and construing this Agreement.

It is deemed advise that all/any of the liabilities arising or to be incurred during the program shall be entirely shifted to the individual contract to be signed by the by the qualified elderly and differently abled individuals for the employment program.

Th LDU - CDOC is looking forward with a partnership program with the Jollibee Food Corporation.
