Abaday highlighted the need to balance infrastructure development with environmental responsibilities in his special report, as he raised concerns about the massive tree cutting along Macapagal Drive and Masterson Avenue due to road widening projects. Councilor Abaday said the contractors and the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) must be held accountable for replacement of felled trees. COUNCILOR JAMES K. JUDITH II: == Because kami man ang nag abri, Madame Chair.

VICE MAYOR JOCELYN B. RODRIGUEZ (Presiding Officer): Ahh, apil ka?

COUNCILOR JAMES K. JUDITH II: == Yes, Madame Chair.

- VICE MAYOR JOCELYN B. RODRIGUEZ (Presiding Officer): == Okay, thank you. Yes, Councilor Romeo Calizo, you have the floor.
- COUNCILOR ROMEO V. CALIZO: == Thank you very much, Madame Chair. Yeah, I fully agree with the intention of the reporter that Police presence are needed in this particular area.
- VICE MAYOR JOCELYN B. RODRIGUEZ (Presiding Officer): == Why is it only now? Where supposed to be Balubal is quite far, the farthest.
- COUNCILOR ROMEO V. CALIZO: == Madame Chair, now, I'm also been a Commander in the field for quite some time, when I was a Company Commander my company base we call it the Tactical Command Post because that's only a post was in 2C Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental, but my area of responsibility covers the Municipalities of Tangub then it was still a Municipality, Tangub City now, Bonifacio, the Municipality of Tambulig in Zamhoanga del Sur, the far flung area of Josefina, Zamboanga del Sur. It has the mission of neutralizing the threat of the CPP-NPA in those areas before. Bonifacio was only my Tactical Command Post. In the Police parlance, they term it as Police Sub-Station, that's only a base, Madame Chair, but that doesn't mean that your presence is only in your station, the responsibility should be over a certain area which is included in your responsibility, Madame Chair. So, although before the resolution, Madame Chair, will be approve in today's session, I think it would be better referred first to the appropriate committee so that we will hear the Police. Why is there no sub-station in this particular area? But to me, Madame Chair, the presence of our law enforcement is not by establishing only a base for the command in control, there should be a better maneuver, a better scheme that would make their presence felt even in the farthest areas of our City, Madame Chair, because neutralizing the threat of criminalities, the answers is not only by establishing station, Madame Chair, there should be more ideas or schemes that the Police should do other than establishing sub-station because station is just a base, Madame Chair, it does not guarantee a good performance by establishing so many sub-stations, Madame Chair, it's how the Police should work that should spell out the resolution of this problem, Madame Chair. So, again I hope with the guidance of the reporter we first refer this to the appropriate committee, Madame Chair, thank you.
- VICE MAYOR JOCELYN B. RODRIGUEZ (Presiding Officer): == Thank you very much, Councilor Romeo Calizo. Yes, Councilor Ian Achas, you have the floor.
- COUNCILOR CHRISTIAN RUSTICO M. ACHAS: == Maayong Hapon to the Presiding Officer, Jocelyn Bebot Rodriguez. To my fellow Councilors, kanatong tanan mga igsoon.

Madame Chair, way back 2017, Barangay Puerto had already the Sub-Station or so called Police Community Outpost or they called it Suh-Station. Now, it is somewhere in the Purok 8 the last purok of Barangay Puerto. We have there during my time, we have free water, expenses provided by the Barangay, electricity, naa nay silda sa ilalum, it is a 2 story building intended for Police Station. So naa siyay silda, naa na siyay computer, I provided all the basic needs being an Office or the need of the precinct. Ang akong ku-an nag wonder kung nganong nakaabot didto sa Balubal and what happen to the Police Station of Barangay Puerto? Because since 2007 up

until now in Covid I provided everything they needed gani, Madame Chair, naa didto ang City Mobile Force Batallion, naa pud didto ang Oro Task Force, naa pud didto ang Station 6 and what happen nga didto man nakaabot sa Balubal nga unta igo naman lang sila mulingkod, mo occupy sa building naa nay computer, there are sets of computer naay duha ka silda babae ug lalaki, naay tubig, naay kuryente and a two story building. And ako lang, Madame Chair, nga unta atong e-include ang Barangay Puerto ug what happen nga nganong didto gibutang ang sa Balubal nga naa na may establishment.

- VICE MAYOR JOCELYN B. RODRIGUEZ (Presiding Officer): == So, existing na na siya? Precisely, why you will be discussing.
- COUNCILOR CHRISTIAN RUSTICO M. ACHAS: == That will be all, Madame Chair.
- VICE MAYOR JOCELYN B. RODRIGUEZ (Presiding Officer): == Okay, thank you very much. So, kung naa nay existing you might as well you plan for the sub-station. Yes, Majority Floor Leader, Atty. Edgar Cabanlas.
- COUNCILOR EDGAR S. CABANLAS (Majority Floor Leader): == Thank you very much, Madame Chair. Kining atong mga function as City Officials or National Government Officials this is part of their ordinary responsibilities and function and every time that we do their job we cannot just padala dayon ta og appreciation kay mahurot atong panahon ang uban pud magmahay unless this is an extraordinary performance beyond the call of duty pwede nato na e-recognize but kung ordinaryo lang nato nga trabaho part ni sa ilang trabaho. And then, yes let us refer this first to the Committee of Police for proper observance of protocol. That would be my suggestion, Madame Chair.

In this connection, we would like to direct your attention to the pertinent provisions of law pertaining to the operation and regulation of cockpits, specifically on derby, to wit:

City Ordinance No. 4373-94 CHAPTER 171: COCKPITS

SECTION 736. Definition of terms:

xXx

- g. Regular Cockfight A cockfight held on Sundays and/or legal Holidays.
- h. Special Cockfight A cockfight held on days other than Sundays and Legal Holidays for special purposes.
- i. Special Permit A permit secured from the Commission for International Derby or the City Mayor for local derby, as the case may be, to hold cockfighting on days other than Sundays and Legal Holidays.


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SECTION 738. Special cockfighting. - Special cockfighting shall likewise be allowed on special and legal holidays from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. upon prior application and approval of the City Council through an ordinance for the purpose and the corresponding permit issued by the City Mayor, except on the days not allowed by law, to wit:

- 1. New Year's Day (January 1)

- 7. On the occasion of agricultural, commercial or industrial fairs, carnival or exposition within the month of the City fiesta.

SECTION 739. Derby.- Derby shall be allowed once a month and for a duration not exceeding two days in each duly licensed cockpit with an interval of at least six (6) days. One additional derby for a duration not exceeding two days may be allowed on the occasion of the City or Barangay Fiesta where the cockpit is located and also during the Christmas Season. Such additional Derbys. may not be covered by the 6-day interval. In all cases, shall derby be allowed only upon prior approval of the City Council through an ordinance for the purpose and the corresponding permit issued by the City Mayor, except on the days not allowed by law. The filing of applications for derby with the Sanggunian Panlungsod shall be made at least thirty (30) days before the holding of the same. [Amended by Ordinance No. 5347-96; Ordinance No. 8832-2003]

On the account of the foregoing, provided that the above provision of law is duly complied with, then this office opposes no legal objection to such application and submits to the sound wisdom and discretion of the Honorable Members of the City Council.

Contract for Line Extension

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Contract made and entered into this _____ day of ______, 2024 in the City of Cagayan de Oro, Philippines by and between:

CAGAYAN ELECTRIC POWER & LIGHT CO., INC., a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, office address at Fr. Masterson Ave., Upper Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, herein represented by its Vice President & Head, Customer Services Division, ENGR. JOREY T. ALFARO, PME, hereinafter known and referred to as CEPALCO.

- and -

CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO, a National Government Unit duly organized and existing under laws of the Republic of the Philippines with office address at Cagayan de Oro City, herein represented by its City Mayor, HON. ROLANDO A. UY, hereinafter referred to as CUSTOMER.

WITNESSETH;

WHEREAS, CEPALCO as the sole distributor of Light and Power in the City of Cagayan de Oro, Municipalities of Tagoloan, Villanueva, and Jasaan, Misamis Oriental is willing and able to sell to the CUSTOMER Power and Energy; and

WHEREAS, CUSTOMER is willing and able to purchase Power and Energy from said CEPALCO;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenant and agreement of the parties, hereto, for themselves, their successors and assigns have mutually agreed as follows:

- 1. That CEPALCO obligates itself to upgrade its lines to serve the customer's COMMERCIAL SUBDIVISION BALUBAL SUBD. RELOCATION PHASE 2, located at Salubal, Cagayan de Oro City, as indicated in the working plan, hereto attached as Annex "A" forming an integral part of this contract;
- 2. That pursuant to the upgrading which CEPALCO hereby undertakes, the CUSTOMER shall advance to CEPALCO the sum of SIX MILUON TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX and 45/100 (Php 6,262,186.45), Philippine Currency, representing the total cost of the Line Extension and other electrical hardware and materials, as per estimate marked as Annex "B" hereto attached forming an integral part hereof:
- 3. That the CUSTOMER shall pay the herein above-mentioned amount upon execution of the contract;
- 4. That the execution of the project shall commence upon full payment of the required advance as mentioned above.
- 5. The CUSTOMER recognizes the ownership of the lines by CEPALCO and therefore CUSTOMER shall in all cases, interpose no objection or conditions whatsoever, to CEPALCO or to anyone, if any customer of CEPALCO shall be tapped to said lines or uses the poles as a joint pole user;
- 6. In cases of variations of route or plans, which are not attributable to CEPALCO, the additional cost due to relocation or variations during

the construction stage shall be to the sole account of the CUSTOMER. CUSTOMER represents that the areas where the lines or poles shall be located shall be permanent. The cost for any relocation of lines, poles, guy wires, supporting structures, and other distribution facilities, during and after completion of the lines and substation shall be borne by the CUSTOMER or any person making the request, as the case may be.

- 7. That prior to payment and execution of the project, the CUSTOMER shall secure a right-of-way grant or easement from any lot owner affected by said line extension project, without right of reimbursement of the easement fee and/or all other related expenses, and submit the document evidencing the grant or easement, as well as other required documents including but not limited to swom statements, certificate of title, tax declarations and receipts/invoices, to CEPALCO;
- 8. That for safety reasons and/or to comply with the minimum safe clearance required by the Philippine Electrical Code, CUSTOMER agrees and shall ensure that no trees or structures will be planted or built directly underneath or near the primary lines of CEPALCO within the lot or premises CUSTOMER. In the event CEPALCO determines the existence of any tree or structure underneath or near said lines, CUSTOMER shall upon receipt of advice from CEPALCO, cut, or trim the trees, or remove the structure, as the case may be, at CUSTOMER'S own expense.
- 9. That CEPALCO shall refund the amount advanced by the CUSTOMER in cash at the rate of seventy-five percent (75%) of the gross distribution revenue derived (per Par. 2.62 of the Amended Distribution Services and Open Access Rules (Amended DSOAR) issued by the Energy Regulatory Commission of ERC) from the herein subject line extension computed at the end of June or December following the month the line extension is completed and for every six (6) months thereafter payable within thirty (30) days from date of computation until the total amount herein advanced by the CUSTOMER is fully refunded, provided that the aggregate refund shall in no case be more than the amount advanced by the CUSTOMER, provided further that refund shall start after the CUSTOMER shall have paid the full amount herein stipulated. The parties hereto agree that the said advanced amount shall not bear interest whatsoever.
- 10. That in compliance with Amended Distribution Services and Open Access Rules (DSOAR) Paragraph 2.62 issued by the Energy Regulatory Commission of ERC, the developer has submitted to CEPALCO the following:
 - a) A sworn statement from the developer of a certification from the House and Land Regulatory Board (HLURB) that the cost hereof was not incorporated in the purchase price of the sold properties; and,
 - b) An Affidavit of Publication executed by the Editor-in-Chief of other responsible officers of the newspaper of general circulation wherein the announcement that the cost thereof was not incorporated in the cost of the sold properties was published, together with a copy of the newspaper issue containing published announcement and with a statement on the information on the area or areas where the newspaper is being circulated.

Copies of which are attached and marked as Annex "E" and Annex "F", respectively, and are also binding and made an integral part of this contract):

That each party confirms that no payment, commission, accommodation, favor, gift or promise of the same, nor any form of inducement or reward has, or will be, offered to any director, official, employee, representative or agent of the other party (including their relatives within the second degree of affinity or consanguinity), or any related commany, in connection with this transaction. The **DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT FIELD OFFICE 10**, a national government agency and existing under the laws of the Philippines, with office at Masterson Avenue, Upper Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City herein duly represented by its Regional Director, **RAMEL F. JAMEN**, and hereinafter referred to as the "**DSWD FIELD OFFICE 10**".

- WITNESSETH -

WHEREAS, the CID conducts Community-Based Livelihood Skills Training, free of charge for the residents of Regional Haven for Women and Home for Girls and its environs as part of the City Government's Livelihood Program to be conducted in the venue chosen by the DSWD FIELD OFFICE 10.

WHEREAS, DSWD FIELD OFFICE 10 is committed to providing social welfare and development programs, particularly through the provision of Livelihood skills training to the in-center clients of Regional Haven for Women and Home for Girls that would help mitigate hunger, poverty and ensure economic resiliency;

WHEREAS, both organizations recognized the need to establish a partnership to develop sustainable livelihood and capacity-building programs to improve the social well-being, occupational function, and economic viability of beneficiaries and ensure women and children's economic resiliency as soon as they are reintegrated back to their respective communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the PARTIES mutually agree to implement a Training Program for the enhancement of women's and children's skills for them to become productive members of society, with the following responsibilities:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO THRU THE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DIVISION

- Provide tivelihood skills training for the beneficiaries of the DSWD FIELD OFFICE 10;
- 2. Appoints a qualified and experienced Trainer to handle the program as technical support for skills development.
- Assist and monitor the conduct of Community-Based Skills Training and Capability Development Training;
- 4. Provide the equipment to be used during skills training in case the DSWD FIELD OFFICE 10 cannot provide the equipment (subject to availability);
- 5. Assist in the organization of the graduates and registration of the association;
- 6. Pay for the Trainer's Honoraria amounting to Php 1,200.00 per session.
- 7. Support in referral of beneficiaries for employment opportunities in collaboration with existing partner employment agencies.
- 8. Conduct joint monitoring with DSWD representatives during the duration of training programs.
- 9. Issues Certificates of Training to trainees upon completion of the training Program.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF DSWD FIELD OFFICE 10

- Provide the CID with a list of training beneficiaries
- 2. Provides a conducive training venue and workshop area
- 3. Ensure to provide orientation of the beneficiaries concerning the aim of the training before enrolment;
- 4. Ensure that the beneficiaries perform and complete the training course;
- 5. Be responsible for the safekeeping of borrowed equipment from the CID;
- 6. Provides meals and snacks for the training team and training participants
- 7. Provide training materials for the beneficiaries to comply the required standard of skills development;
- Monitor or track progress of individual beneficiaries in coordination with CID designated Coordinator;
- Spearhead the conduct of regular feed backing with CID at least every week or until project ends. This includes the status of all beneficiaries who have completed the training program whether they are employed or have engaged in entrepreneurship;
- 10. Equip women beneficiaries with additional capacity building necessary for personal development and resiliency skills after completion of the skills program;
- 11. Create a Success Stories Documentation in collaboration with the Community Improvement Division.

JOINT RESPONSIBILITIES

For and in consideration of mutual support to be provided to women and children empowerment skills development project beneficiaries, The City Government of Cagayan de Oro through the Community Improvement Division and DSWD X acknowledges that this partnership will complement efforts to provide better economic opportunities to target beneficiaries through Skills Trainings. In addition, both agencies shall:

- Define the cost-sharing of resources according to the identified skills development of target beneficiaries.
- Participate in regular feedback to track the progress and impact of interventions.

EFFECTIVITY AND DURATION

This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect on the date of signing by both Parties hereto and shall continue to exist for one (1) year from the said date with the option for renewal. In case of termination, the party initiating the termination shall notify the other party at least three (3) months from the date of the effectivity of termination without prejudices to the obligations already incurred. Specifically, activities that take time to finish and have already been commenced shall continue until conclusion with due consideration to the effectivity of the termination as herein contemplated.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION CLAUSE

Any difference arising out of this DEED shall be settled through amicable means, such as but not limited to, mutual consultation and negotiation. At any rate, any dispute, claim, controversy, or disagreement arising out of or in connection with this Agreement that cannot be settled amicably within thirty (30) calendar days after written notice, shall be resolved or adjudicated in accordance with the provision of Presidential Decree No. 242 in relation to Chapter 14, Book IV of Executive Order No. 292, otherwise known as the Revised Administrative Code of 1987.

DATA PRIVACY CLAUSE

The parties hereby undertake to uphold and abide by laws, rules, policies, and regulations, including, but not necessarily limited to, Republic Act No. 10173 otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act of 2012 which protects any data that may be collected, processed, stored or otherwise used.

AMENDMENTS CLAUSE

This Agreement may be amended or modified only in writing upon consent of all Parties.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:



This DATA SHARING AGREEMENT ("DSA") is entered into by, between and among:

BUREAU OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE, a government agency under the Department of Finance, existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at 8/F EDPC Building, BSP Complex, Roxas Boulevard, Manila represented herein by its Executive Director, CONSOLACION Q. AGCAOILI, hereinafter referred to as "BLGF";

BUREAU OF INTERNAL REVENUE, a government agency under the supervision and control of the Department of Finance, established and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at BIR National Office Building, Agham Road, Diliman, Quezon City herein represented by its Commissioner, ROMEO D. LUMAGUI, JR., hereinafter referred to as "BIR";

(For purposes of this DSA, the above-mentioned Local Government Units shall collectively be called "PROTOTYPE LGUs" and the BLGF, BIR, LRA and the PROTOTYPE LGUs, are herein referred to collectively as "PARTIES")

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, under Section 2 of Republic Act (RA) No. 8424, or the National Internal Revenue Code (NIRC) of 1997, as amended, the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR), under the supervision and control of the Department of Finance and its powers and duties shall comprehend the assessment and collection of all national internal revenue taxes, fees, and charges, and the enforcement of all forfeitures, penalties, and fines connected therewith, including the execution of judgments in all cases decided in its favor by the Court of Tax Appeals and the ordinary courts.

WHEREAS, under Section 1 of Executive Order (EO) No. 649, s. 1981, as amended by EO No. 292, s. 1987, the Land Registration Authority (LRA) is a government agency under the Department of Justice (DOJ) mandated to issue decrees of registration and certificates of title and register documents, patents and other land transactions for the benefit of landowners, Agrarian Reform-beneficiaries and the registering public in general;

WHEREAS, under Section 33 of EO No. 292, s. 1987, the Bureau of Local Government Finance (BLGF) under the supervision of the Department of Finance shall, among others, be the focal agency and authority in overseeing the treasury and assessment operations of local government units (LGUs) and ensuring the fiscal sustainability of LGUs towards growth and development;

WHEREAS, the PROTOTYPE LGUs, pursuant to Section 22 (5) of the RA No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 (LGC), under corporate powers, has the power to enter into contracts.

WHEREAS, the PROTOTYPE LGUs, pursuant to Section 129 of the LGC, has the "power to create its own sources of revenue and to levy taxes, fees and charges subject to the provisions (of the Local Government Code), consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy;"

WHEREAS, the Local Governance Reform Project (LGRP) is a project that will focus specifically on improvements to the real property tax (RPT) administration and management reforms. In particular, the Project will: (i) develop institutions and policy formulation for property valuation; (ii) implement property tax valuation database and information systems; (iii) enhance RPT administration for selected LGUs; and (iv) professionalize local assessors and strengthen capacity of LGUs, with the BLGF as the executing agency;

WHEREAS, BLGF, in providing technical assistance to the LGUs and as the executing agency of the LGRP, is planning to establish, deploy and maintain a property tax valuation database and information systems which will facilitate data analyses, at both sub-national and national levels, of government's performance vis-a-vis real property tax (i) assessment and (ii) collection;

WHEREAS, in separate Memoranda of Agreement dated and signed last 11 May 2022, the BLGF has partnered with the PROTOTYPE LGUs, BIR, and LRA for the purpose of establishing, deploying, and maintaining a real property tax valuation database and information systems and the creation of the Technical Working Group (TWG) for the drafting and finalization of this DSA.

WHEREAS, the PARTIES endeavor to respect every person's right to access information while upholding the protection of everyone's personal information pursuant to RA No. 10173, otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act of 2012, its implementing rules and regulations and other related laws:

WHEREAS, National Privacy Commission (NPC) Circular No. 2020-03 dated 23 December 2020 provides the rules governing data sharing agreements;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of RA No. 8792, otherwise known as the Electronic Commerce Act of 2000, provides, among others, that the State recognizes the vital role of information and communications technology (ICT) in nation-building; the need to create an information-friendly environment which supports and ensures the availability, diversity and affordability of ICT products and services.

WHEREAS, pursuant to their respective lawful mandates, the PARTIES are personal information controllers (PIC) who have authority and custody over real property-related information;

WHEREAS, pursuant to their respective lawful mandates, the PARTIES hereby agree to share real property-related information that they collect from its registered entities subject to the condition that the BLGF shall implement and maintain reasonable and appropriate organizational, physical, and technical security measures for the protection and lawful use of the said information;

WHEREAS, the PARTIES agree to treat the personal and sensitive information shared among, and between each other with the utmost confidentiality; collect, process, and use the same solely for the furtherance of their respective lawful mandate; and comply with the provisions of this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and covenants set forth herein, the PARTIES hereto mutually agree as follows:

I. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE

Pursuant to RA No. 10173, its implementing rules and regulations, as well as other relevant issuances of the National Privacy Commission, this DSA is hereby entered into by the PARTIES to govern the sharing of real-property related information, which may contain personal information and sensitive personal information under the authority and custody of the PARTIES pursuant to their respective mandates, between and among each other, for the purpose of establishing, deploying, and maintaining a real property valuation database and information system under the LGRP.

II. DEFINITION OF TERMS

For the purposes of this DSA, the following terms shall be defined as:

- 1) Anonymization is a process by which personally identifiable information (PII) is irreversibly altered in such a way that a PII principal can no longer be identified directly or indirectly, either by the PII controller alone or in collaboration with any other party. Any information is considered anonymized if there is no possible means to identify the data subject, that is, the PIC and/or any other person are incapable of singling out an individual in a data set, from connecting two records within a data set (or between two separate data sets) and from any information in such dataset.
- Data subject refers to an individual whose personal information is processed.
- 3) Compliance Officer for Privacy (COP) is an individual or individuals who perform some of the functions of a Data Protection Officer (DPO) in these cases:

- (a) Local Government Units (LGUs). Aside from having a DPO, a component city, municipality, or barangay may designate a COP, as long as the COP shall be under the supervision of the DPO.
- (b) Government Agencies. Aside from having a DPO, a government agency that has regional, provincial, district, city, municipal offices, or any other similar sub-units, may designate or appoint COP for each sub-unit. The COPs shall be under the supervision of the DPO.
- 4) Data Center refers to a centralized repository, which may be physical or virtual, may be analog or digital, used for the storage, management, and dissemination of data including personal data.
- 5) Data Protection Officer (DPO) refers to an individual designated by the head of agency to be accountable for the agency's compliance with the Data Privacy Act, and the rules and regulations issued by the NPC. A DPO must be an organic employee of the government agency; Provided, that a government agency may not have more than one (1) DPO¹.
- 6) Data sharing is the sharing, disclosure, or transfer to a third party of personal data under the custody of a personal information controller to one or more other personal information controller/s.
- 7) **General public** refers to those who are not owners of or do not possess any legal interest over the real property.
- 8) Interested party refers to the party with legal interest over the subject property. Such legal interest is the right to have the advantage accruing from anything; any right in the nature of property, but less than the title; a partial or undivided right; and a title to a share. This also includes government agencies and instrumentalities that may require real property-related information necessary to carry out their functions.
- 9) Personal information refers to any information whether recorded in a material form or not, from which the identity of an individual is apparent or can be reasonably and directly ascertained by the entity holding the information, or when put together with other information would directly and certainly identify an individual.
- 10) Personal information controller refers to a person or organization who controls the collection, holding, processing or use of personal information, including a person or organization who instructs another person or organization to collect, hold, process, use, transfer or disclose personal information on his or her behalf. The term excludes:
 - (a) A person or organization who performs such functions as instructed by another person or organization; and
 - (b) An individual who collects, holds, processes or uses personal information in connection with the individual's personal, family or household affairs.
- 11) **Processing** refers to any operation or any set of operations performed upon personal information including, but not limited to, the collection, recording, organization, storage, updating or modification, retrieval, consultation, use, consolidation, blocking, erasure or destruction of data.
- 12) Sensitive personal information refers to personal information:
 - (a) About an individual's race, ethnic origin, marital status, age, color, and religious, philosophical or political affiliations;
 - (b) About an individual's health, education, genetic or sexual life of a person, or to any proceeding for any offense committed or alleged to have been committed by such person, the disposal of such proceedings, or the sentence of any court in such proceedings;
 - (c) Issued by government agencies peculiar to an individual which includes,

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- but not limited to, social security numbers, previous or cm-rent health records, licenses or its denials, suspension or revocation, and tax returns; and
- (d) Specifically established by an executive order or an act of Congress to be kept classified.
- 13) Real property-related information refers to data concerning the identification and features of a property in relation to its valuation, taxation, transaction history, and other purposes required by the mandates of the respective PARTIES. This may include personal information or sensitive personal information.

III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Duties and Responsibilities of the PARTIES. The following are the duties and responsibilities of the PARTIES:
 - (a) The PARTIES hereby agree to share, among and between each other, real property-related information, and the personal and sensitive personal information included thereto, under their authority and custody pursuant to their respective mandates, in accordance with the provisions of the data privacy laws;
 - (b) The PARTIES hereby bind themselves to preserve the confidentiality of any personal and sensitive personal information shared and received pursuant to this agreement, together with other information arising from the execution of the LGRP that the PARTIES may deem as confidential;
 - (c) The PARTIES shall take efficient and effective measures to ensure the accuracy, correctness, and timeliness of the real property-related information to be shared to the database;
 - (d) The PARTIES shall take the necessary measures to inform their respective data subjects, through a privacy notice, regarding the: (1) sharing of their personal and sensitive personal information therein; (2) the purpose and objective of this DSA; (3) the categories of their personal data that will be shared, the recognition of their rights as data subjects; and (4) other relevant information that would sufficiently inform their respective data subjects of the nature and extent of the data sharing and the manner of processing involved.
 - (e) The PARTIES shall use all standards, designs, specifications, systems, databases, and all other work products developed in relation to this DSA only in connection with the LGRP and this Agreement or for any other purpose as identified and approved by the PARTIES;
 - (f) The PARTIES shall comply with principles and provisions of data sharing contained in the Policy on Data Sharing of Personal Information, attached as Annex A to this Agreement, to ensure the privacy, confidentiality and protection of personal information and sensitive personal information; and
 - (g) The LGUs shall designate two (2) Compliance Officers for Privacy (COPs) for the Local Assessment and Local Treasurer's Office respectively. The designated COPs must be organic employees of the respective offices and must comply with the qualifications set forth by the National Privacy Commission. Provided that the COPs shall be the personnel who perform collection and processing of personal and sensitive personal information for the respective offices.
- 2) Data Description, Purpose, and Functions. The following personal information, and sensitive personal information shall be shared among the PARTIES in connection with or as an incident to the gathering and sharing of real property-related information from the enumerated documents, to wit:

- 3) Updates, changes, and additions to the real property-related information to be shared. The complete details of the real property-related information to be shared between and among the parties, and the agreed type of access thereto are hereby contained in the Supplier-Input-Process-Customer (SIPOC) Sheet, hereby attached as Annex B. Any changes or additions to the real property-related information shared between and among the PARTIES shall hereby be updated and incorporated to the SIPOC Sheet with the consent of the PARTIES.
- 4) Restriction on reproduction of the shared documents containing real property-related information. The PARTY from which the original document containing real property-related information has originated from, retains the right and authority to issue the said documents upon proper and valid request of their respective public clients/customers. The PARTIES herein do not consent nor authorize the reproduction of the respective documents containing real property-related information and the disclosure of such reproduced documents to the public by any of the PARTIES from which the document did not originate from.
- 5) **Designation of Data Protection Officers (DPOs).** The following personnel are hereby designated as Data Protection Officers of the respective PARTIES:

In the event that the person holding the DPO position is separated for any cause, the corresponding PARTY shall immediately take appropriate steps to designate a new DPO therein.

IV. DURATION AND TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

1) **DURATION.** This DSA shall commence from the date of execution and signing and shall remain in force and binding based on the continued existence of the purpose/s of this DSA, unless terminated or suspended by any of the PARTIES for reasonable ground, without prejudice to the availability of entering into a new data sharing agreement.

This DSA shall be subject to the conduct of periodic reviews which should take into consideration the sufficiency of the safeguards implemented for data privacy and security.

2) TERMINATION.

- (a) ANY PARTY, at its reasonable discretion may suspend or terminate its participation in the DSA through the service of a written notice for this purpose indicating any of the following grounds:
 - i. Upon substantial evidence of material breach;
 - ii. Failure by ANY OTHER PARTY to comply with the terms and conditions of the DSA; ad
 - iii. In the event of unreasonable delay or inaction by ANY OTHER PARTY.
- (b) In the event of termination due to any of the aforementioned grounds, the rights of that party to use and possess any real property-related information shared herein shall be terminated along with the DSA in so far as that party at fault is concerned. The party at fault shall be obligated to promptly return to the party not at fault and dispose of all real property-related information within seven (7) calendar days from receipt of the written notice.

V. OPERATIONAL DETAILS

- CREATION OF THE REAL PROPERTY INFORMATION SYSTEM. The real
 property-related information shared among and between the PARTIES shall be
 stored and processed in a system application to be provided by the BLGF pursuant
 to its functions as the executing agency of the LGRP;
- 2) METHOD OF DISCLOSURE. The PARTIES shall periodically share the real property-related information to the database through the PIPs or their authorized office and or employee as authorized by the PARTIES' respective PICs.
- 3) TRANSFER AND PROCESSING. The PARTIES shall undertake to ensure the security of the Personal and Sensitive Personal Information and other confidential information while in their custody or in transit or while being transmitted through the channels or media authorized in this DSA. Each PARTY shall process Personal Information and Sensitive Personal Information and other confidential information disclosed and/or transferred to it pursuant to this DSA, in accordance with the contractual stipulations and statutory provisions that apply to the processing of such personal and sensitive information;
- 4) ACCESS AND SAFEGUARDS FOR DATA PRIVACY AND SECURITY. The real property-related information shall only be accessible to the designated DPOs and their authorized representatives. The PARTIES shall establish reasonable and appropriate safeguards and security measures to ensure the confidentiality,

integrity, and security of the real property-related information shared or disclosed by the PARTIES among and between each other pursuant to this DSA. The PARTIES shall be responsible for preventing the unauthorized access and use of such real property-related information in their respective custody. The PARTIES shall determine their authorized representatives which shall have access to the database, whose functions are directly and intimately related to the purpose for accessing the database thereto. Unless otherwise exempted under existing laws, the PARTIES are likewise prohibited from further sharing or disclosing such real property-related information and other personal and sensitive personal information to any unauthorized PARTY without prior written consent of the originating PARTY or the Data Subjects, as the case may be;

- 5) RETENTION, DESTRUCTION, OR DISPOSAL. Unless applicable laws or regulations allow or require a shorter period for retention, the real property-related information, personal and sensitive personal information subject of this DSA shall be stored and retained by the PARTIES so long as may be necessary for the pursuit of their lawful mandate. Upon termination of this DSA, the PARTIES shall, upon instruction of other PARTIES, destroy, delete or return the real property-related information that it received from the requesting PARTY within thirty (30) calendar days from the effective date of termination, unless the said PARTY is mandated or permitted by applicable law to maintain a copy thereof for a longer period and subject to the internal policy of the BLGF on destruction and deletion. Personal and sensitive personal information and other classified information in the custody of a PARTY that requires disposal shall be disposed of and/or discarded by such PARTY in a secure manner that would prevent further processing, unauthorized access, or disclosure to any other person or entity;
- 6) NO LGU-TO-LGU DATA SHARING. This DSA shall not be construed as establishing a data-sharing agreement between and among the PROTYPE LGUs herein. The PROTOTYPE LGUs shall not share any personal and sensitive personal information they own or have received from BIR, LRA, and BLGF to other PROTOTYPE LGUs; and
- 7) ISSUANCE OF JOINT MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR WITH TECHNICAL ANNEX. The PARTIES shall issue a Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) together with the Technical Annex containing all the specific operational details for the use and access of the real property information database and the exchange of information therein.
- 8) DATA BREACH MANAGEMENT. The PARTIES shall regularly monitor its compliance with the security measures provided in this DSA, the JMC and the Technical Annex thereto. In the event of a breach in the data security affecting personal and sensitive personal information, the PARTY shall notify the DPO or any appropriate officer of the other PARTIES in writing, immediately after discovery of such data breach or upon reasonable belief that such data breach has occurred, in accordance with Section 20(f) of the Data Privacy Act.

VI. OTHER PROVISIONS

- 1) Each PARTY shall comply with the Data Privacy Act of 2012 and all other data protection laws, the respective IRR, and other NPC issuances.
- 2) The personal data subject whose right is violated and/or affected my exercise his/her rights provided for by the Data Privacy Act, its IRR, and other NPC Issuances
- 3) A copy of this DSA may be obtained by any- Data Subject from the Office of the Data Protection Officer of the respective PARTIES, subject to compliance with processes and policies of the PARTY concerned. The PARTIES may redact or prevent the disclosure of any detail or information that could endanger its computer network or system, or expose to harm the integrity, availability, or confidentiality of personal data under its control or custody. ANNEX A: POLICY ON DATA SHARING

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines for sharing of personal and sensitive personal information between the BLGF, BIR, LRA, and the PROTOTYPE LGUs. This policy is designed to facilitate efficient and effective governance, while ensuring the protection of individual privacy and confidential information; to ensure that sensitive information is shared in a secure and ethical manner, while also promoting collaboration and cooperation between parties.

Scope:

This policy applies to all the parties of the DSA that collect, use, and store data related to individuals, including but not limited to personal information, health information, financial information, and other sensitive information.

Policy

General

- a. The parties must only share data between each other for a legitimate purpose, as defined by applicable taws, regulations, policies, and procedures.
- Data sharing must be done in accordance with applicable laws, regulations, policies, and procedures, including but not limited to data protection laws, confidentiality laws, and privacy laws.
- c. Before sharing data, the parties must conduct a privacy impact assessment (PfA) to identify potential privacy risks and develop appropriate safeguards to mitigate those risks.
- d. The parties must ensure that the shared data is accurate, complete, and up-to-date, and that appropriate security measures are in place to protect the data from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure.
- e. The parties must ensure that individuals are informed about the collection, use, and disclosure of their personal information in accordance with applicable privacy laws and policies.
- f. The parties must have a designated privacy officer who is responsible for ensuring compliance with applicable laws, regulations, policies, and procedures related to data sharing.
- g. Data sharing between government agencies must be conducted in a manner that protects the privacy and confidentiality of individuals' personal information.
- h. The parties must only share data with other stakeholders when there is a legitimate need to do so, and only to the extent necessary to accomplish the purpose of the data sharing
- i. The parties must establish clear procedures and protocols for data sharing that include identifying the specific data to be shared, the purpose for sharing the data, and the specific individuals or entities that are authorized to access the data.
- j. The parties must ensure that all individuals and entities that are authorized to access shared data are properly trained in data security and privacy protection.
- k. The parties must implement appropriate security measures to safeguard the shared data, including but not limited to encryption, access controls, and monitoring of data access.
- The parties must conduct periodic reviews of data sharing practices to ensure that they remain necessary, appropriate, and in compliance with applicable laws and regulation.
- m. The parties must maintain accurate records of all data sharing activities, including the specific data shared, the purpose for sharing the data, and the individuals or entities that accessed the
- n. The parties must cooperate with audits and investigations conducted by internal or external auditors or investigators with respect to their data sharing practices.

Authorization and Approval:

- a. The parties must obtain authorization and approval from the appropriate authority before sharing any data.
- b. The appropriate authority must ensure that the sharing of data is necessary and justifiable.
- c. The appropriate authority must also ensure that the sharing of data is in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

Secure Data Sharing:

- a. All data sharing must be conducted in a secure manner, using encryption, secure data storage, and other appropriate security measures.
- b. Data must only be shared with authorized personnel who have a legitimate need to access the information.
- c. All data sharing activities must be documented and auditable.

Data Accuracy and Integrity:

- a. The parties must ensure that the data being shared is accurate and up-to-date.
- All data sharing activities must be conducted in accordance with the policies and procedures of both the sending and receiving agencies.
- c. The parties must ensure that the data being shared is not altered or modified in any way without proper authorization.

Privacy and Confidentiality:

- All data sharing activities must be conducted in accordance with applicable privacy and confidentiality laws and regulations.
- b. The parties must take appropriate measures to protect the privacy and confidentiality of any personal information being shared.
- c. Personal information must only be shared with authorized personnel who have a legitimate need to access the information.

Disposition of Shared Data:

- a. The parties must have policies and procedures in place for the secure disposal of shared data when it is no longer needed.
- All data sharing activities must be conducted in accordance with the policies and procedures of both the sending and receiving agencies.

Reporting and Oversight:

- a. The parties must report any incidents or suspected incidents of unauthorized data sharing to the appropriate authority.
- b. The appropriate authority must conduct regular oversight and monitoring of data sharing activities to ensure compliance with this policy.

Enforcement:

- 1. Violations of this policy may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination of employment or contract, as well as criminal prosecution, if applicable.
- 2. Failure to comply with this policy may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination of employment, legal action, and/or other appropriate measures.
- 3. Each party is responsible for implementing and enforcing this policy within their agency. The DPO of each party must ensure that appropriate controls and security measures are in place to protect shared data. The DPO of all parties must work together to establish a data sharing agreement that outlines the procedures and protocols for data sharing between stakeholders.

Review:

This policy will be reviewed and updated as necessary to ensure compliance with applicable laws, regulations, policies, and procedures, and to reflect changes in technology and best practices in data management and privacy.

This policy will be reviewed on an annual basis to ensure that it remains relevant and effective. Any necessary changes to this policy will be approved by the DPO of each party.




LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

Moreover, the above-mentioned MOA has been forwarded to and thoroughly reviewed and revised by the City Legal Office, which interposes no objection thereto.¹



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

THIS MEMORANDUM	OF AGREEMENT	("Agreement") is executed this

SYCIP GORRES VELAYO & CO., a general professional partnership duly organized and existing by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines and a member firm of Ernst & Young Global Limited ("EY"), with business address at 6760 Ayala Avenue, Makati City, represented herein by its Chairman and Country Managing Partner, WILSON P. TAN, and hereinafter referred to as "SGV",

AND

THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO, a local government unit created and existing under Philippine laws with office address at Cagayan de Oro City Hall, Capistrano-Hayes Streets, Cagayan de Oro City, represented herein by THE HONORABLE ROLANDO "KLAREX" A. UY, City Mayor, and hereinafter referred to as the "Cagayan de Oro City Government":

WHEREAS, SGV has known competence, technical knowledge, expertise, and experience in promoting the Philippines to foreign investors as an investment destination, including through its publication of "Doing Business in the Philippines", an investment guide on doing business in the Philippines that provides an overview of the Philippines' social, political, and economic climate, and presents important information on the country's assets and strategic positioning that can be useful for investors who have plans of setting up business in the country. It showcases not only relevant historical and statistical data on the economy but also lists and discusses key pieces of legislation that govern business transactions in the country;

WHEREAS, the Cagayan de Oro City Government intends to replicate the same concept of publication that will specifically showcase Cagayan de Oro City as a rich source of investment opportunities for both local and foreign investors because of its strategic location, skilled and highly educated human resources, diverse local products, excellent infrastructure, and peace and order situation that is conducive to trade and commerce, plus reasonable local business tax rates, and efficient and business-friendly local government services in the City;

WHEREAS, SGV is able and willing to provide free technical assistance to the Cagayan de Oro City Government in the conceptualization, design, coverage, and publication of "Doing Business in Cagayan de Oro City" in printed and digital versions;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth in this Agreement, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. DEFINITION OF TERMS

Unless otherwise clearly required by the context, the following terms used in this Agreement shall have the respective meanings defined hereunder:

- 1.1. The term "Publication" or "Work Product" shall mean the "Doing Business in Cagayan de Oro City" publication, and its production in print or any other medium such as but not limited to a digital or electronic copy, or in CD or DVD format.
- 1.2. The term "Services" shall mean the technical advisory services of SGV in relation to the "Doing Business in Cagayan de Oro City" publication.

2. PROVISION OF SERVICES

Subject to the terms detailed in this Agreement, SGV undertakes to assist the Cagayan de Oro City Government in coming up with the design and coverage of the "Doing Business in Cagayan de Oro City" publication as well as reviewing the information compiled relating to the process of setting up of business in Cagayan de Oro City ("City"), its local taxation, its current social, political and economic profile, demographics and other data related thereto.

2.1. In particular, SGV agrees to:

- 2.1.1. Provide the outline and the report template; and
- 2.1.2. Review the draft prepared by Cagayan de Oro City Government staff and suggest revisions or additions.

2.2. The Cagayan de Oro City Government agrees to:

- 2.2.1. Compile the data and documents and write the draft;
- 2.2.2. Review suggested revisions or additions by SGV and approve the draft; and
- 2.2.3. Print the Publication.

At no cost to the Cagayan de Oro City Government, SGV will provide the Services described above to the Cagayan de Oro City Government as an independent contractor and not as its employee, agent, partner, or joint venturer.

Neither the Cagayan de Oro City Government nor SGV shall have any right, power, or authority to bind the other.

3. INTEGRITY OF CONTENT

- 3.1. The Cagayan de Oro City Government shall provide all the content and relevant information to be included in the Publication.
- 3.2. The Cagayan de Oro City Government shall be solely responsible for the veracity, accuracy, and completeness of the information to be presented in the Publication or Work Product.
- 3.3. The Cagayan de Oro City Government shall hold SGV free and harmless of any responsibility, and SGV shall not accept, nor may be made to accept, responsibility for any claim of loss, whether imputed, potential, or actual, arising from any inaccuracy in the information presented or arising from printing or dissemination of the Publication, either in whole or in part.

In providing the Services, SGV shall rely upon the relevant information provided by the Cagayan de Oro City Government and its understanding of the current Philippine tax laws, regulations, rules, and issuances of the relevant tax authorities before the completion of the Services.

Should such information provided by the Cagayan de Oro City Government, laws, regulations, rules, and issuances change, the information in the Publication or Work Product may need to change as well.

SGV will not be responsible for updating the information therein unless specifically requested to do so under a separate written agreement.

4. COSTS OF PUBLICATION

The costs of production and publication of the Work Product as well as all other costs related thereto such as printing and distribution, *inter alia*, shall be borne by the Cagayan de Oro City Government, in accordance with the applicable procurement, auditing, and accounting rules and regulations.

As far as practicable, all materials and supplies and other expenses necessary and incidental to the said project should be provided for and procured by the Cagayan de Oro City Government, in accordance with the applicable procurement, auditing, and accounting rules and regulations, prior to the commencement of the project.

5. COPIES FOR DISTRIBUTION AT THE LAUNCH

It is agreed that the Work Product may be reproduced and disseminated, in accordance with this Agreement, in either printed or digital form such as in CD or DVD which shall have security features or a protected format at all times.

It is further agreed that the Cagayan de Oro City Government will print at least three (3) copies of the Work Product at its own expense, in accordance with the applicable procurement, auditing, and accounting rules and regulations, for distribution at a simple but fitting launch of the Work Product. The Cagayan de Oro City Government may opt to distribute the Work Product in digital form to the rest of the attendees.

6. COPYRIGHT

SGV acknowledges that the Cagayan de Oro City Government shall own the copyright to the Work Product and subsequent updates or revisions prepared by the Cagayan de Oro City Government.

SGV may use data, software, designs, utilities, tools, models, systems, and other methodologies and know-how that it owns ("Materials") in performing the Services. Notwithstanding the delivery of the Work Product, SGV shall retain intellectual property rights in the Materials (including any improvements or knowledge developed while performing the Services), and in any working papers compiled in connection with the Services.

7. TERMINATION

This Agreement may be terminated by either the Cagayan de Oro City Government or SGV without need of judicial intervention at any time by giving at least five (5) days' written notice to the other Party. Should either Party fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Agreement and not rectify such failure within five (5) days of having received a notice from the aggrieved Party to do so, then this Agreement shall automatically be considered rescinded. Upon termination, cancellation, or rescission of this Agreement, the authority granted by either Party with respect to each other is deemed terminated.

Unless terminated earlier as provided in this Section 7, this Agreement shall terminate on the completion of the Services. The submission by SGV of a "No further comments" notification to the Cagayan de Oro City Government shall be construed as the completion of the Services under this Agreement.

In addition, SGV may immediately terminate all or any portion of this Agreement upon notice to the Cagayan de Oro City Government if SGV believes in good faith that applicable laws, professional obligations, requirements, or standards (including those related to independence or conflicts matters) require such termination.

8. WARRANTY

The Cagayan de Oro City Government hereby represents and warrants that it is duly authorized and empowered to execute, enter into, deliver, and perform this Agreement and that such action does not conflict with or violate any provision of law, regulation, policy, contract or other instrument to which it is a party or by which it is bound and that this Agreement constitutes a valid and binding obligation enforceable in accordance with its terms.

9. ANTI-CORRUPTION PROVISIONS

The Parties undertake that they:

- 9.1. Will fully comply with, and will procure that their officers, partners, and employees fully comply with the Anti-Corruption Laws as defined below;
- 9.2. Will use reasonable and proportionate efforts to procure that their agents and contractors fully comply with the Anti-Corruption Laws;
- 9.3. Will not do, or omit to do, any act that will cause the other Party to be in breach of the Anti-Corruption Laws;
- 9.4. Has in place, and shall maintain in place throughout the term of this Agreement, policies, and procedures to ensure compliance with the Anti-Corruption Laws and will enforce them where appropriate;
- 9.5. Will notify or have notified those providing services for it, including its officers, partners, employees, agents, and contractors, that it does not accept or condone the payment of bribes (including facilitation payments) on its behalf; and
- 9.6. Will promptly report to the other Party any request or demand for any undue financial or other advantage of any kind received by it in connection with the performance of the Services.

For the avoidance of doubt, Anti-Corruption Laws shall be understood by the Parties to mean any applicable anti-bribery and anti-corruption laws and regulations, including Act No. 3815 or the Revised Penal Code of the Philippines, and Republic Act No. 3019, as amended, or the Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act of the Philippines.

Any Party in breach of the obligations in this Section 9 shall indemnify, keep indemnified, and hold harmless the other Party and its partners, directors, officers, and employees, from and against all losses, damages, costs (including but not limited to legal costs and disbursements) arising from or incurred by reason of the breaching Party's breach of the Anti-Corruption Laws.

10. GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

This Agreement, and any non-contractual matters or obligations arising out of this Agreement or the Services, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, without giving effect to the conflict of laws rules.

11. SEVERABILITY

If one or more provisions of this Agreement shall be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain valid and shall be given full force and effect.

12. WAIVER/AMENDMENTS

No waiver by a Party to any provision of this Agreement shall be binding unless made expressly and in writing. Any amendment or modification of this Agreement must be in writing and signed by both Parties.
