



### LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

This refers to the original Ordinance No. 14562-2023, dated 29 May 2023, entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING HONORABLE CITY MAYOR ROLANDO A. UY REPRESENTING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO (DONEE), TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE DEED OF DONATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS, UNIFIED PROJECT MANAGEMENT OFFICE-FLOOD CONTROL MANAGEMENT CLUSTER (DONOR), REPRESENTED BY ITS PROJECT DIRECTOR, RAMON A. ARRIOLA III, COVERING THE LATTER'S DONATION OF CONSTRUCTED FACILITIES/STRUCTURES FOR THE USE OF THE PAGATPAT RESETTLEMENT SITE (PHASE I) IMPLEMENTED UNDER THE FLOOD RISK MANAGEMENT PROJECT FOR CAGAYAN DE ORO RIVER (FRIMP-CDOR) CONTRACT PACKAGE 3 (KAUSWAGAN-CARMEN-BALULANG-NAZARETH-MACASANDIG), LOCATED IN SITIO PAMALIHI, BARANGAY PAGATPAT, THIS CITY, UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS STIPULATED THEREIN", in view of the completion of the CONSTRUCTED FACILITIES/STRUCTURES for the Pagatpat Resettlement Site Phase 1.







In line with this, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) has issued a **CERTIFICATE OF ACCEPTANCE AND TURN-OVER** to be signed by the DPWH and the City Government, upon the completion of the Pagatpat Resettlement Area Land Development. This Certificate formalizes the turn-over for the City Government to assume the responsibility of the Land Development Works with regards to custody, security, care and maintenance of the structures. It serves as the proper documentation for this formalization.

Therefore, there is no longer a need for a Deed of Donation between the City Government and the DPWH. This is because the City Government, being the owner of the lot, and the DPWH, being a national agency, has constructed the facilities and structures under the FRIMP-CDOR Contract Package 3, exclusively for the benefit of the City Government and its constituents, with the intent of ultimately transferring the custody, security, care and maintenance of the structures to the City Government.

Based on the foregoing, I respectfully request the Honorable Body's appropriate action <u>to</u> <u>repeal the aforementioned ORDINANCE NO. 14562-2023 accordingly, and to grant the undersigned the authority to sign the CERTIFICATE OF ACCEPTANCE AND TURN-OVER.</u>

The DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY - REGIONAL OFFICE X, a government agency mandated via Executive Order No. 128 to "provide central direction, leadership, and coordination of scientific, and technological efforts and ensure that the results there from are geared and utilized in areas of maximum economic and social benefits for the people", with an official address at J.V. Seriña St. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental, 9000 and represented herein by its Regional Director, ROMELA N. RATILLA, herein referred to as "DOST-X"

The LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, Province of Misamis Oriental, a Local Government Unit (LGU) duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, 1st Class highly-urbanized city with an official address at Office of the City Mayor, Cagayan de Oro City, represented herein by its City Mayor, ROLANDO A. UY, hereinafter referred to as "LGU-CDO";

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, DOST is the lead in Disaster Prevention and Mitigation, one of the four mutually reinforcing Disaster Risk Reduction and Management thematic pillars as provided in the Republic Act No. 10121 or the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 that created the National Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (NDRRMC) that implemented the National Disaster Risk Reduction Management Plan (NDRRMP);

WHEREAS, the LGU through its local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (DRRMO) is one of the frontliners in the implementation of the NDRRMP and in the protection of communities, families, and individuals from the adverse effects of disasters and in keeping the citizenry away from areas with known hazards;

**WHEREAS, DOST** as the chair in the Prevention and Mitigation Pillar, employs three major strategies-knowing the risks, communicating the risks, and implementing prevention and mitigation measures and strongly advocates the use of Science, Technology, and Innovation to generate the knowledge on disaster risk reduction and management;

**WHEREAS**, **the LGU** is the basic political unit in building the disaster resilience of communities and institutionalizing arrangements and measures for reducing disaster risks, including projected climate risks and enhancing disaster preparedness and response capabilities;

WHEREAS, DOST plays a key role in providing oversight for the generation and dissemination of science-informed disaster and climate risk information to all sectors and levels, and the horizontal and vertical integration of DRRM-CCA in policy, planning, and budgeting, among others.

**WHEREAS**, the LGU takes the lead in preparing for, responding to, and recovering from the effects of any disaster in the barangay, city, municipality, province, or region as stated in Republic Act No. 10121 Section 15;

WHEREAS, DOST provides technical training and workshops on knowing the risks, understanding the risks, assessing the hazards and relevant information that will capacitate the LGUs to implement activities and strategies that will enhance resilience;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** for and in consideration of the foregoing, the PARTIES hereby agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) under the following terms and conditions:

### I. DOST-X shall:

- Provide capacity building to Local Government Units for disaster preparedness and mitigation, and disaster risk reduction technologies of DOST such as but not limited Early Warning Systems;
- Provide orientation and training on the use of Multi-hazard assessment platforms such as GeoRiskPH a geospatial information management and analysis for hazards and risk assessment its applications, the HazardHunterPH, GeoAnalyticsPH, GeoMapperPH, PlanSmart, FaultFinder, 3DEarthRisk as necessary;
- 3. Introduce the DRR Technologies and innovations of DOST and other agencies.;

4. Provide technical support for the development and implementation of identified projects for DRRM under a specific Memorandum of Agreement as identified and agreed later.

#### II. LGU-CDO shall:

- 1. Allow and commit to utilize the DOST DRR technologies and innovations such as but not limited to the early warning systems;
- 2. Allow and support the conduct of orientation and training to the local DRRM officers on the use of Multi-hazard assessment platforms such as GeoRiskPH a geospatial information management and analysis for hazards and risk assessment and its applications, the HazardHunterPH, GeoAnalyticsPH, GeoMapperPH, PlanSmart, FaultFinder, 3DEarthRisk as needed:
- 3. Allow collaboration with DOST-X and other stakeholders in the planning of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation projects;
- 4. Provide the needed data, information, and mechanism to be able to design, develop, and implement the identified projects;
- 5. Pass pertinent resolutions to facilitate the implementation and success of disaster prevention and mitigation projects and activities.

In this connection, kindly be informed that this Office has thoroughly reviewed the above-mentioned draft MOU and submit the following recommendation/s:

a) Stipulation on Venue be included, which should provide that the City of Cagayan de Oro as the exclusive venue. A sample provision is hereby quoted, to wit:

"Any question or issue raised by the Parties based on this MOU shall be settled amicably between them. Should amicable settlement not be possible, the regular courts or competent quasi-judicial bodies of Cagayan de Oro City shall have the sole and exclusive jurisdiction over any disputes or claims that may arise out of, or in connection with this MOU."

b) The Parties be respectively referred to as, to wit:

CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO, a local government unit, with office address at 2nd floor, Executive Building, City Hall, Cagayan de Oro City, Philippines, represented herein by its City Mayor, HON. ROLANDO "KLAREX" A. UY, hereinafter referred to as "City Government of Cagayan de Oro";



#### WITNESSETH:

**WHEREAS**, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

**WHEREAS**, in 2018, the World Health Organization (WHO) recognized that road traffic injuries are the leading cause of death for people aged between five (5) and 29 years old;

**WHEREAS**, in 2017, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) recorded 2,204 road deaths involving youth aged 0-19 years old;

**WHEREAS**, 27.7 million school children in the Philippines walk or commute to school daily using various mode of transport;

**WHEREAS**, there is an increasing incidence of road traffic injuries involving children from when they start going to school at five (5) years old, leading to deaths or lifelong disabilities;

**WHEREAS**, the State recognizes the right of children to special protection from all forms of neglect, abuse and other conditions prejudicial to their development, including exposure to safety risks, while on roads;

**WHEREAS**, to keep children safe on Philippine roads, the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) has been supporting the local modeling of the Child Road

Traffic Injury Prevention (CRTIP) program in priority local government units, including the Parties, which includes best practice interventions under the Safe System Approach to road safety;

**WHEREAS**, as the CRTIP program was piloted in Zamboanga City beginning 2019, while implementation in Cagayan de Oro City began in 2022, Zamboanga City has offered to share best practices to address their road safety problem with Cagayan de Oro City;

**WHEREAS**, the Parties have agreed to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding to become sister cities with respect to road safety and other programs and for promoting mutual understanding and goodwill as well as technical exchange and cooperation on the various dimensions of local governance;

**WHEREAS**, Section 22(a)(5) and (c) of Republic Act (RA) No. 7160, othelwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that a local government unit shall have the power to enter into contracts, with the prior approval of the Sanggunian concerned; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties have been authorized by their respective Sanggunian to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Parties desiring to promote and strengthen ties of collaboration and share good practices on road safety, with a specific focus on the special protection needed by child road users, in pursuit of the betterment of the welfare of their constituents and creating opportunities for mutual growth of units, agree as follows:

### ARTICLE 1 Scope

The Parties hereby agree to explore areas of collaboration and cooperation with respect to making roads safer for au road users, especially children as vulnerable road users, through but not limited to the following:

- a. Participation in exchanges of best practices, strategies, technologies, data, and other information relative to road crashes, deaths, injuries and the implementation of interventions under the globally-recognized Safe System approach to road safety; and
- b. Engagement in and support for projects, activities events relating to road safety, including initiatives to inform, educate, and raise awareness of road users about the road safety problems and existing or proposed interventions.

### ARTICLE 2 Responsibilities

Each Party shall:

a. Nominate and appoint official representatives to coordinate with the other Party for the purpose of developing, implementing, monitoring, and evaluating exchanges, projects, activities, and events under this Memorandum of Understanding;

- b. Authorize relevant office/s and/or official/s within their respective city governments to share information upon request by the other Party pursuant to the objectives of this Memorandum of Understanding;
- c. Provide technical, financial, or other kinds of support for the execution of this MOU; and
- d. Promulgate such issuances or cause the preparation of such documents as may be necessary to execute this Memorandum of Understanding.

### ARTICLE 3 Term

This Memorandum of Understanding is effective as of the date of signing and shall continue in effect, subject to revocation under Article 4 of this Memorandum of Understanding.

### **ARTICLE 4** Revocation

Either Party shall have the right to revoke this Memorandum of Understanding at any time, subject to the submission of at least three (3) months prior written notice to the other Party.

### ARTICLE 5 Periodic Review

This Memorandum of Understanding may be reviewed annually or as the need arises upon reasonable request by either of the Parties to determine any necessary amendments or modifications thereto.






