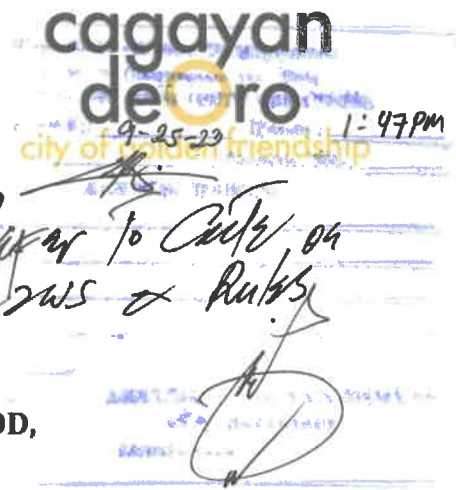

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

This refers to the original Ordinance No. 14562-2023, dated 29 May 2023, entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING HONORABLE CITY MAYOR ROLANDO A. UY REPRESENTING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO (DONEE), TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE DEED OF DONATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS, UNIFIED PROJECT MANAGEMENT OFFICE-FLOOD CONTROL MANAGEMENT CLUSTER (DONOR), REPRESENTED BY ITS PROJECT DIRECTOR, RAMON A. In line with this, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) has issued a **CERTIFICATE OF ACCEPTANCE AND TURN-OVER** to be signed by the DPWH and the City Government, upon the completion of the Pagatpat Resettlement Area Land Development. This Certificate formalizes the turn-over for the City Government to assume the responsibility of the Land Development Works with regards to custody, security, care and maintenance of the structures.¹ It serves as the proper documentation for this formalization.

Therefore, there is no longer a need for a Deed of Donation between the City Government and the DPWH. This is because the City Government, being the owner of the lot, and the DPWH, being a national agency, has constructed the facilities and structures under the FRIMP-CDOR Contract Package 3, exclusively for the benefit of the City Government and its constituents, with the intent of ultimately transferring the custody, security, care and maintenance of the structures to the City Government.

Based on the foregoing, I respectfully request the Honorable Body's appropriate action to repeal the aforementioned ORDINANCE NO. 14562-2023 accordingly, and to grant the undersigned the authority to sign the CERTIFICATE OF ACCEPTANCE AND TURN-OVER.

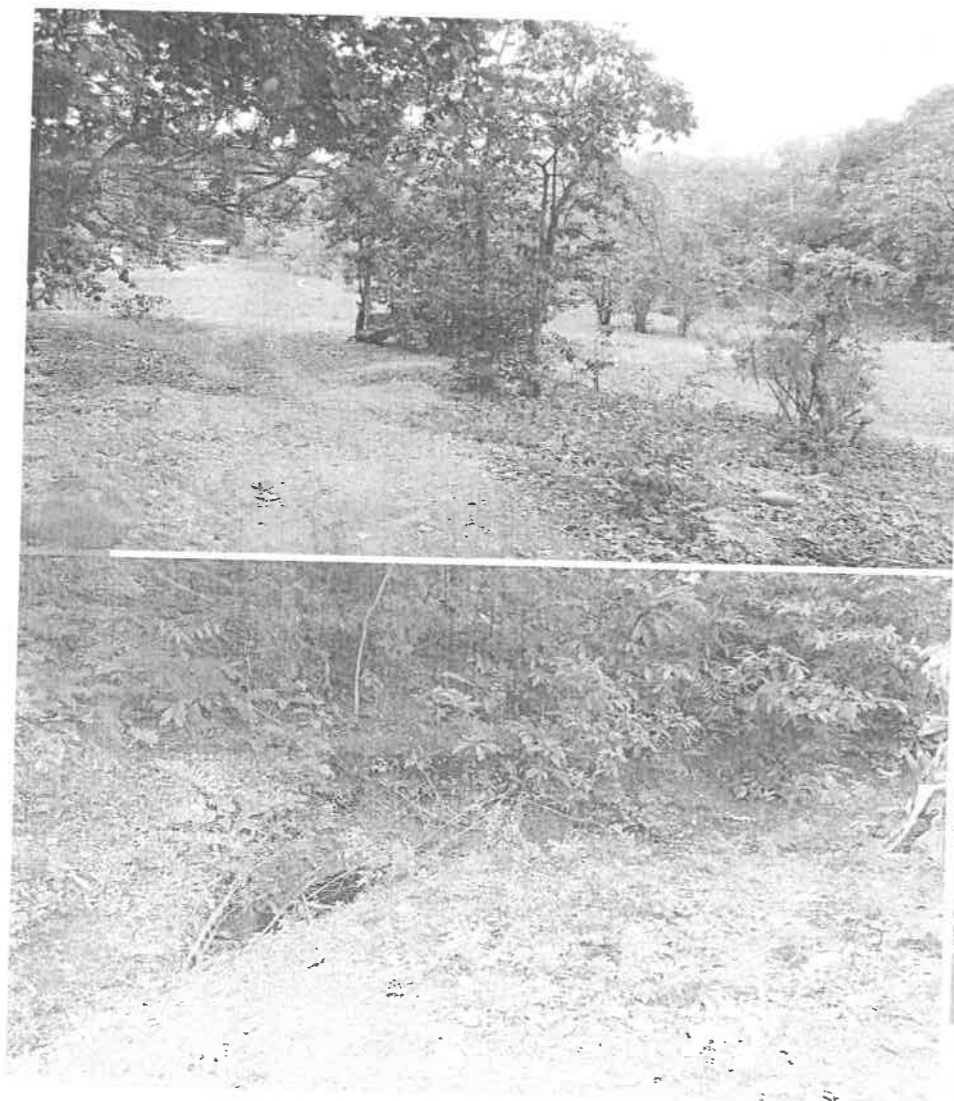

DOST to conduct HANDA Pilipinas DRRM expo in CDO

The Department of Science and Technology is set to conduct HANDA Pilipinas: Innovations in Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Expo 2023 (Mindanao leg) in CDO with the theme, "Enhancing Resilience and Sustainability for Mindanao" on September 14-16, 2023 at Limketkai Atrium, Cagayan de Oro City.

The HANDA Pilipinas expo aims to enhance the country's resilience by raising awareness in DRR, informing and capacitating the stakeholders and the public on the DRR technologies of DOST and other agencies, and accelerating the practical use of DOST-developed, funded, and supported innovations and technologies.

This expo is supported by the Regional Development Council (RDC-10) through Resolution No. 23 (s.2023) and by the Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (RDRRMC-10) through Resolution No. 08 (s.2023). This will be organized in partnership with the Office of Civil Defense (OCD-10), and the lead agencies of the four thematic pillars of DRRM; Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG-10), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD-10) and the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA-10).

This event will be the first DRRM technology exposition in Mindanao. There will be an exhibit of innovations and technologies in disaster prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, recovery, and rehabilitation. Expected are 80 national exhibitors and 30 local exhibitors who will showcase their technologies, programs, projects, research and development, and services on DRR. Exhibits are coming from DOST agencies, State Universities and Colleges, Science Foundations, other government agencies, and the private sector.

The Reference for Emergency and Disaster (RED) Book for LGUs will also be soft-launched during the event.

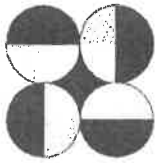
Forums, tech pitching, training, workshops will be conducted in partnership with the OCD and DILG. Among the forums to be conducted are Risk communication for media and LGU DRR Information Officers, Flood warning system for Mindanao River Basins, GeoRiskPH platforms for LGU-DRRM officers, Bamboo Forum on technologies and carbon credits, and more. Speakers are experts from DOST-PHIVOLCS, DOST-PAGASA, other agencies and from the private sector.

Among the expected participants in the forums are the local government units from various parts of Northern Mindanao and neighboring regions, media practitioners, academe, volunteer organizations, and private sectors in Mindanao.

The Mindanao leg of the HANDA Pilipinas expo will give a spotlight on bamboo as a strategy for DRR and Climate Change Adaptation (CCA). Bamboo is widely known for its very high carbon sequestration capacity thus reducing greenhouse gas, its good soil and water holding capacity

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thus preventing soil erosion and flooding. It is also an effective windbreaker. The exhibit viewers will learn more about bamboo in this expo including opportunities for livelihood and business. Incidentally, September is also Bamboo Month.

At the same venue, DOST-PAGASA will set up an inflatable mobile planetarium for learning scientific concepts of the Universe to the general public, and to elementary and high school students. This concept includes the size and content of the observed universe, its creation, history and possible future, the development of the solar system. Each batch includes lecture and film showing /stargazing sessions.

Other than the forums and the exposition, a DOST DRR-CCA quiz bowl and TikTok contest will also be conducted at the atrium. The general public is invited to participate in the 3-day event. The exhibit will be open to everyone for free viewing from September 14-16, from 10AM to 7PM.

The HANDA Pilipinas: Innovations in Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Exposition 2023 is a nationwide event. The Luzon leg will be held at the World Trade Center, Pasay City, from July 27-30 with the theme "Megacities at Risk". The Visayas leg will be conducted from November 8-10, during the 10th year anniversary of Super Typhoon Yolanda with the theme "STY remembered: Understanding risks and preventing disasters."

The title "HANDA Pilipinas" means two things: "HANDA" as a call to action; and "HANDA" as an end-state. Given the compounding risks that the country is exposed to, the HANDA Pilipinas is an intensified information and advocacy platform to prevent hazards from becoming disasters and to enhance resilience.

This Expo is organized by DOST agencies and offices; the Technology Application and Promotion Institute (DOST-TAPI), Science and Technology Information Institute (DOST-STII), Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical, Astronomical Services Administration (DOST-PAGASA), Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS), the three DOST regional offices of NCR, Eastern Visayas and Northern Mindanao, the Office of the Undersecretary for Regional Operations (OUSecRO) and the DRR-CCA unit of the Office of the DOST Secretary.

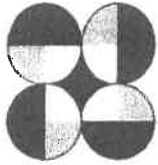

WHEREAS, DOST as the chair in the Prevention and Mitigation Pillar, employs three major strategies-knowing the risks, communicating the risks, and implementing prevention and mitigation measures and strongly advocates the use of Science, Technology, and Innovation to generate the knowledge on disaster risk reduction and management;

WHEREAS, the LGU is the basic political unit in building the disaster resilience of communities and institutionalizing arrangements and measures for reducing disaster risks, including projected climate risks and enhancing disaster preparedness and response capabilities;

WHEREAS, DOST plays a key role in providing oversight for the generation and dissemination of science-informed disaster and climate risk information to all sectors and levels, and the horizontal and vertical integration of DRRM-CCA in policy, planning, and budgeting, among others.

WHEREAS, the LGU takes the lead in preparing for, responding to, and recovering from the effects of any disaster in the barangay, city, municipality, province, or region as stated in Republic Act No. 10121 Section 15;

WHEREAS, DOST provides technical training and workshops on knowing the risks, understanding the risks, assessing the hazards and relevant information that will capacitate the LGUs to implement activities and strategies that will enhance resilience;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the PARTIES hereby agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) under the following terms and conditions:

I. DOST-X shall:

1. Provide capacity building to Local Government Units for disaster preparedness and mitigation, and disaster risk reduction technologies of DOST such as but not limited Early Warning Systems;
2. Provide orientation and training on the use of Multi-hazard assessment platforms such as GeoRiskPH a geospatial information management and analysis for hazards and risk assessment its applications, the HazardHunterPH, GeoAnalyticsPH, GeoMapperPH, PlanSmart, FaultFinder, 3DEarthRisk as necessary;
3. Introduce the DRR Technologies and innovations of DOST and other agencies.;

4. Provide technical support for the development and implementation of identified projects for DRRM under a specific Memorandum of Agreement as identified and agreed later.

II. LGU-CDO shall:

1. Allow and commit to utilize the DOST DRR technologies and innovations such as but not limited to the early warning systems;
2. Allow and support the conduct of orientation and training to the local DRRM officers on the use of Multi-hazard assessment platforms such as GeoRiskPH a geospatial information management and analysis for hazards and risk assessment and its applications, the HazardHunterPH, GeoAnalyticsPH, GeoMapperPH, PlanSmart, FaultFinder, 3DEarthRisk as needed;
3. Allow collaboration with DOST-X and other stakeholders in the planning of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation projects;
4. Provide the needed data, information, and mechanism to be able to design, develop, and implement the identified projects;
5. Pass pertinent resolutions to facilitate the implementation and success of disaster prevention and mitigation projects and activities.

General Provisions

Activities as provided in terms of this MOU shall immediately commence upon the effectiveness of this Memorandum of Understanding. Once specific projects are identified, a specific Memorandum of Agreement will be executed.

and

the **CITY GOVERNMENT OF ZAMBOANGA**, with principal office address at _____, represented herein by its City Mayor, **HON. JOHN M. DALIPE**, hereinafter referred to as "City Government of Zamboanga";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, in 2018, the World Health Organization (WHO) recognized that road traffic injuries are the leading cause of death for people aged between five (5) and 29 years old;

WHEREAS, in 2017, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) recorded 2,204 road deaths involving youth aged 0-19 years old;

WHEREAS, 27.7 million school children in the Philippines walk or commute to school daily using various mode of transport;

WHEREAS, there is an increasing incidence of road traffic injuries involving children from when they start going to school at five (5) years old, leading to deaths or lifelong disabilities;

WHEREAS, the State recognizes the right of children to special protection from all forms of neglect, abuse and other conditions prejudicial to their development, including exposure to safety risks, while on roads;

WHEREAS, to keep children safe on Philippine roads, the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) has been supporting the local modeling of the Child Road

Traffic Injury Prevention (CRTIP) program in priority local government units, including the Parties, which includes best practice interventions under the Safe System Approach to road safety;

WHEREAS, as the CRTIP program was piloted in Zamboanga City beginning 2019, while implementation in Cagayan de Oro City began in 2022, Zamboanga City has offered to share best practices to address their road safety problem with Cagayan de Oro City;

WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding to become sister cities with respect to road safety and other programs and for promoting mutual understanding and goodwill as well as technical exchange and cooperation on the various dimensions of local governance;

WHEREAS, Section 22(a)(5) and (c) of Republic Act (RA) No. 7160, othelwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that a local government unit shall have the power to enter into contracts, with the prior approval of the Sanggunian concerned; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have been authorized by their respective Sanggunian to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Parties desiring to promote and strengthen ties of collaboration and share good practices on road safety, with a specific focus on the special protection needed by child road users, in pursuit of the betterment of the welfare of their constituents and creating opportunities for mutual growth of units, agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 **Scope**

The Parties hereby agree to explore areas of collaboration and cooperation with respect to making roads safer for au road users, especially children as vulnerable road users, through but not limited to the following:

- a. Participation in exchanges of best practices, strategies, technologies, data, and other information relative to road crashes, deaths, injuries and the implementation of interventions under the globally-recognized Safe System approach to road safety; and
- b. Engagement in and support for projects, activities events relating to road safety, including initiatives to inform, educate, and raise awareness of road users about the road safety problems and existing or proposed interventions.

ARTICLE 2 **Responsibilities**

Each Party shall:

- a. Nominate and appoint official representatives to coordinate with the other Party for the purpose of developing, implementing, monitoring, and evaluating exchanges, projects, activities, and events under this Memorandum of Understanding;

- b. Authorize relevant office/s and/or official/s within their respective city governments to share information upon request by the other Party pursuant to the objectives of this Memorandum of Understanding;
- c. Provide technical, financial, or other kinds of support for the execution of this MOU; and
- d. Promulgate such issuances or cause the preparation of such documents as may be necessary to execute this Memorandum of Understanding.

**ARTICLE 3
Term**

This Memorandum of Understanding is effective as of the date of signing and shall continue in effect, subject to revocation under Article 4 of this Memorandum of Understanding.

**ARTICLE 4
Revocation**

Either Party shall have the right to revoke this Memorandum of Understanding at any time, subject to the submission of at least three (3) months prior written notice to the other Party.

**ARTICLE 5
Periodic Review**

This Memorandum of Understanding may be reviewed annually or as the need arises upon reasonable request by either of the Parties to determine any necessary amendments or modifications thereto.



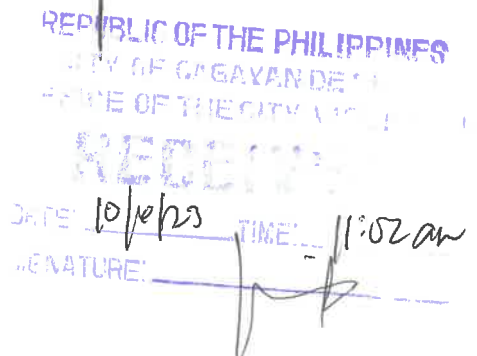
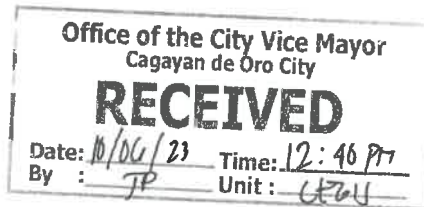
