42 **B. ON SPECIAL REPORT**

43 i. Councilor James K. Judith II reported that the Local Water Utilities Administration (LWUA)
 44 should consider the opinion of the Department of Justice (DOJ) regarding its takeover of
 45 the management of the Cagayan de Oro Water District (COWD). He suggested that the
 46 body should pass a resolution urging LWUA to withdraw its appointment of the COWD
 47 Interim General Manager and members of the Board of Directors to address legal concerns
 48 and restore proper governance within the COWD.

49 *Action Taken: The Body adopted Resolution No. 14985-2024.*

50 ii. Councilor Romeo V. Calizo reported on the lack of a K9 kennel facility at the Cagayan de
 51 Oro City Police Office (COCPO). He emphasized the importance of such facility for housing
 52 and training K9 units, which are crucial for enhancing security and law enforcement
 53 operations. The report called for immediate action to provide financial support for the
 54 COCPO's K9 program.

55 *Action Taken: The Body adopted Resolution No. 14986-2024.*

56 iii. Councilor Roger G. Abaday reported on the complaint regarding the expensive food
 57 market tent rentals for the Higalaay Festival Food Market to be held at the Rio de Oro
 58 Boulevard. He highlighted concerns about the exorbitant rental, which could negatively
 59 impact on the small vendors' participation and profitability. The report emphasized the
 60 need to review and adjust the rental prices to ensure they are fair and reasonable for all
 61 vendors, considering the public nature of the venue.

62 *Action Taken: The Report was referred to the Committees on Ways and Means, on Games and*
 63 *Amusement, on Tourism and on Social Services.*

ORDINANCE NO. 14837-2024

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR THE GRANT OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF 20% EQUITY FOR THE COST OF ON-SITE LAND ACQUISITION BY URBAN POOR ASSOCIATIONS OR QUALIFIED BENEFICIARIES OF ON-SITE SOCIALIZED HOUSING PROGRAM OF THE CITY PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 13178-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE SOCIALIZED HOUSING PROGRAM OF 2016", AS AMENDED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, Section 6-A of Ordinance No. 13178-2016, entitled: "An ordinance consolidating and further amending Ordinance No. 9888-2005 and Ordinance No. 10046-2006, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Socialized Housing Program for the Underprivileged and Homeless Citizens of Cagayan de Oro City, formerly Piso-Piso Program, so as to provide herein additional guidelines and to provide penalty for the violation thereof and for other purposes", as amended by Ordinance No. 13753-2019, states that:

"SECTION 6-A. – For On-Site Development where an intent to sell has been issued by the lot owner and an agreement has been reached as to its reasonable market price, the City Government shall only provide Twenty Percent (20%) of the total agreed acquisition cost, representing equity, at no obligation on the part of the association-beneficiaries."

Whereas, the City Housing and Urban Development Department (CHUDD) recommended the adoption of general guidelines on how urban poor homeowners associations can qualify and avail of such assistance to comply with accounting and auditing rules and regulations and streamline the process and efficiently spend the financial resources of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the 20th City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) in session that:

SECTION 1. The following guidelines shall be strictly followed and complied in the grant of financial assistance in the form of 20% Equity for the cost of on-site land acquisition by urban poor associations or qualified beneficiaries of on-site Socialized Housing Program of the City pursuant to Ordinance No. 13178-2016, entitled: "An ordinance consolidating and further amending Ordinance No. 9888-2005 and Ordinance No. 10046-2006, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Socialized Housing Program for the Underprivileged and Homeless Citizens of Cagayan de Oro City, formerly Piso-Piso Program, so as to provide herein additional guidelines and to provide penalty for the violation thereof and for other purposes", as amended by Ordinance No. 13753-2019, viz:

A) QUALIFICATIONS

- 1) Homeowners Association (HOA) certified by the DHSUD and accredited by the Sangguniang Panlungsod;
- 2) Urban Poor Association under the Presidential Commission of the Urban Poor;

*HOA and Urban Poor Association shall be subject to qualifications set by Ordinance No. 13178-2016, *aka* Comprehensive Socialized Housing Program of 2016.

B) GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1) Applicant HOA or Urban Poor Association can avail of a maximum of 20% of the cost of the land to be acquired for on-site development.
- 2) Application shall be done by the association.
- 3) The BIR Zonal Value shall serve as the benchmark assessment for the price of the property.
- 4) Existing lot of each HOA member shall not exceed 150 square meters.
- 5) The financial assistance shall be paid directly to the property seller/vendor.



C) PROCEDURE

- 1) Applicants shall submit a proposal of intent applying for the financial assistance together with the PCUP or SEC Certificate (if not yet certified under DHSUD), locational map of the property, and tax declaration. The letter should be addressed to the Department Head of CHUDD.
- 2) CHUDD shall only review applications with complete minimum requirements and applicants shall be notified should there are any deficiencies, or the application is approved preliminarily.
- 3) Applicants shall submit the following documents:
 - i) DHSUD Certification,
 - ii) City Council Resolution of accreditation,
 - iii) Masterlist of HOA members,
 - iv) Notarized intent to sell by the property owner concerned,
 - v) Zoning Certificate,
 - vi) Updated true copy of titles and/or back titles,
 - vii) Bank statement,
 - viii) Proposed subdivision plan,
 - ix) HOA Board Resolution stating that the HOA members are willing to acquire the property.
- 4) CHUDD shall review the BIR zoning value of the property and conduct socio-economic profiling of the HOA members. CHUDD shall also convene the City Engineering Office, Office of the Building Official, City Local Environment and Natural Resources Office, and City Assessors Office to conduct site inspection. Moreover, CHUDD shall finalize and prepare the evaluation report.
- 5) Upon the completion of the evaluation report, CHUDD shall forward the application to the City Council through the Subdivision and Landed Estate Committee for an enactment of an Ordinance declaring the lot/s occupied as On-Site Resettlement Area.
- 6) Upon the enactment of an Ordinance declaring the lots occupied as On-Site Resettlement, CHUDD shall endorse the application to the Local Finance Committee for financial assessment, issuing as a result a certification guaranteeing the viability of such assistance considering the fiscal capacity of the City. Qualified applicants may be advised to be provided assistance on the succeeding fiscal year.
- 7) Upon the issuance by the Local Finance Committee of a Certificate of Availability of Funds (CAF), CHUDD shall forward the application to the City Legal Office for the preparation of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) stipulating therein the mode of release, obligations of parties and penalties of applicants for violation of the agreement. CHUDD shall not proceed with the application if there is no proof of initial payment or Letter of Guarantee.
- 8) The City Legal Office shall then forward the application to the City Mayor affixing the following: (1) MOA, and (2) Endorsement letter to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for passage of an Ordinance Granting the association the City's 20% Equity on the cost of land acquisition and granting authority to the City Mayor to sign the MOA with the association.
- 9) The MOA signing shall not proceed without Deed of Assignment, and if an approved PSDP/DP/PALC is needed for the application.
- 10) A formal turnover of the check payable to the bank/seller/vendor shall be conducted for the purpose.

D) DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

- 14) Hoard resolution stating that the HOA members arc willing to acquire the property
- 15) Proof of initial payment or letter of guarantee if funded through CMP
- 16) Approved DP/PSDP/PALC (if applicable or whichever is applicable)
- 17) Deed of assignment (if applicable)

On the part of the City Government:

- 1) Technical and Evaluation Report
- 2) SES profiling
- 3) Ordinance declaring the lots occupied as on-site resettlement
- 4) Certificate of availability of funds
- 5) Ordinance for 20% equity assistance
- 6) Ordinance authorizing the City Mayor to enter into Memorandum of Agreement

E) PROCESS FLOW - To streamline the processing for the availment of the financial assistance under Section 6-A of Ordinance No. 13178-2016, as amended, the Process Flow Chart under Annex "A" of this Ordinance is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. There shall be allocated in the annual budget or supplemental budget of the City Government so much amount necessary for the implementation of Section 6-A of Ordinance No. 13178-2016, as amended, covering the grant of 20% equity financial assistance.

For this purpose, the CHUDD shall prepare the budget proposal for the year of implementation thereof as well as the Project Brief for the plan-budget year and ensuing years for inclusion in the Annual Investment Programs (AIPs) of the City.

SECTION 3. The pertinent provisions of Ordinance No. 13178-2016 and other applicable ordinances, rules and regulations pertaining to the socialized housing program of the City Government shall apply in suppletory manner to this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. For this purpose, Ordinance No. 13178-2016, as amended, is hereby further amended accordingly.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.



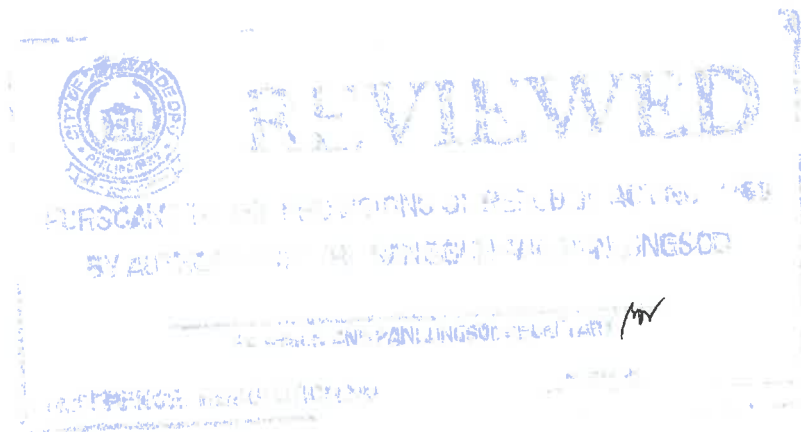



ORDINANCE NO. 14248-2022

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE GROUNDS FOR CANCELLATION OF AWARDS GRANTED TO BENEFICIARIES, THEIR SUBSTITUTION AND THE RULES AND PROCEDURES OF THE CANCELLATION OF AWARDS IN ALL SOCIALIZED HOUSING PROJECTS OWNED AND MANAGED BY THE CITY GOVERNMENT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, RA 7279, otherwise known as the Urban Development and Housing Act of 1992, provides that it shall be the policy of the state to undertake in cooperation with private sector a comprehensive and continuing urban development and socialized housing program to uplift the conditions of homeless citizen in urban areas by making available to them decent housing and basic services;

Whereas, cognizant of the need for housing of its homeless and underprivileged constituents, the City passed Ordinance No. 13178-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Socialized Housing Program of 2016 which consolidates previous housing programs of the city;

Whereas, CHUDD has observed that a significant number of socialized housing project beneficiaries failed to comply with the requirements for their occupancy, failed to reside in the socialized housing units or failed to utilize the lots provided or continuously decline to abide by the rules and regulations imposed by the City Government;

Whereas, these violations committed by some beneficiaries delay the implementation of the socialized housing project of the City Government and deprive other deserving families from availing thereof;

Whereas, this ordinance shall provide rules and procedures for the cancellation of awards of violator-beneficiaries;

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the 19th City Council (*Sangguniang Pantungso*) of Cagayan de Oro in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title - This Ordinance shall be known as an *Ordinance Prescribing the Grounds for Cancellation of Awards Granted to Beneficiaries, Their Substitution and the Rules and Procedures of the Cancellation of Awards in all Socialized Housing Projects Owned and Managed by the City Government.*

SECTION 2. Coverage - These rules and procedures shall apply to all beneficiaries of Socialized Housing Program/Project owned and managed by the City Government.

SECTION 3. Implementing Authority - The City Housing and Urban Development Department shall be the lead agency in implementing the cancellation of awards granted to violator beneficiary.

SECTION 4. Definition of Terms -

- a) **City Socialized Housing** - refers to a City or National Socialized Housing Programs owned or managed by the City Government of Cagayan de Oro for the City's underprivileged and homeless citizens which shall include sites and services development, long term financing, liberalized terms on interest payments, and such other benefits in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 7279, otherwise known as the Urban Development and Housing Act of 1992;
- b) **Absentee Beneficiaries** - refers to a beneficiary of any socialized housing program of the City Government who refused or failed to occupy the housing unit awarded to him/her or any members of his/her immediate family for a period of one (1) year from the date of his/her receipt of entry pass or introduced substantial improvement for lots only;



- c) **Violator-Beneficiaries** - refers to a beneficiary of a socialized housing program of the City Government who willfully and continuously violates the rules and regulations of the socialized housing programs or relocation or those who do refuse to pay their legal monthly amortization for two (2) years, showing lack of interest to pay. It also includes those who instigate or persuade other qualified beneficiaries to do the same;
- d) **Visiting Beneficiaries** - refers to a beneficiary of any socialized housing program of the City who failed to reside continuously his/her awarded unit but visits intermittently or not continuously;
- e) **City Socialized Housing Program Award** - refers to the housing unit or the lot only given to a deserving beneficiary who undergoes screening process of the City Housing and Urban Development Department of the City;
- f) **Masterlist of Beneficiaries** - refers to the consolidated city list of registered beneficiaries of the city socialized housing program, arranged alphabetically and by area of residence. The list shall include other critical information such as name of spouse, income, type of tenure, family size, length of residence in the barangay and/or any other information considered relevant by City Housing and Urban Development Department;

SECTION 5. General Provisions.

- a) The City Housing and Urban Development Department shall conduct semi-annual inventory in all socialized housing projects of the City of the occupancy and residency status of beneficiaries. The inventory shall include the physical condition of the housing units including alterations and list of actual occupants. The Inventory Team of the Department shall prepare and keep the Masterlist of the City Socialized Housing Beneficiaries;
- b) The City Housing and Urban Development Department shall conduct necessary investigation and proper verification of the violator-beneficiaries;
- c) Identified violator-beneficiaries shall be investigated by the Department in collaboration with the Homeowners Association Officers of the housing project;
- d) Photo and documents shall be gathered and secured upon investigation. The following shall serve as evidences:
 - i. Photos of the housing unit under investigation, including but not limited to the front side, back, and interior portion of the said unit;
 - ii. For lot only projects, the photos of the lot shall suffice;
- e) The City Housing and Urban Development Department shall have a List of Violator-Beneficiaries and file the same in individual and separate folder with the attached corresponding documents/evidences.

SECTION 6. Grounds for Cancellation of Award - A beneficiary found guilty of violations of any of the grounds stated hereunder with due notice and hearing shall forfeit the award given to him/her as beneficiary and the award granted shall be canceled. The following are the grounds for the cancellation of award, to wit:

- a) Failure to occupy the awarded units within twenty-one (21) days after the receipt of Entry Pass, or to introduce substantial improvements for lots only awarded to him/her within one (1) year from the date of raffle or issuance of the Certificate of Award, whichever occurred earlier;
- b) Failure to pay for one (1) year the acquisition cost of the awarded lot or unit, under the reasonable payment scheme required by the City Government;
- c) Failure to pay for two (2) years any legal fees (such as incidental fees relative to the conveyance of the subject property), taxes (real property tax or other charges) and other assessment as required by law and/or ordinances;
- d) Selling, transferring or mortgaging the housing unit or lot to any individual, person or



entity except through hereditary succession. Conveyance or sale shall be allowed only after the lapsed of the year limitation period;

- e) Abandonment of the awarded housing units by not occupying for a period of one (1) year, or allowing any third person to occupy the said unit as a visitor for the purpose of circumventing the requirement of the continuous occupancy and residency, or any act of fraud that would violate the purpose of awarding the unit for the beneficiary such as, but not limited to, allowing visitors to occupy the unit in order to confuse the continuous occupancy of the beneficiary;
- f) Misrepresenting, tampering of any document, making false statements in any public document or during interviews and/or submit fake requirements to gain access to any of the City Government's socialized housing program.

SECTION 7. Inventory & Paralegal Section - An Inventory and Paralegal Section shall be created under the City Housing and Urban Development Department (CHUDD) with the following personnel complement:

- a) one (1) Special Investigator II as Section Head, and
- b) six (6) staff members who shall come from the personnel of the CHUDD to be designated by the CHUDD Department Head.

SECTION 8. Duties and Functions of the Inventory & Paralegal Section - The following are the duties and functions of the Inventory and Paralegal Section, to wit:

- a) Conduct inventory of all housing units and beneficiaries under CDORSHP and all other housing projects owned, managed, donated, and transferred to the City Government, and publish an annual Master List of Beneficiaries;
- b) Investigate and conduct hearing of violations by the beneficiaries enumerated in Section 6 of this Ordinance and submit its recommendation for the approval by the CHUDD Department Head in accordance with the procedures hereunder set forth.

SECTION 9. Rules and Procedures - A set of rules and procedures are hereby instituted for the conduct of hearing by the Paralegal Section, to wit:

- a) Violations of any provisions under Section 6 of this Ordinance shall be immediately investigated by the Inventory and Paralegal Section. The Section Head thereof shall designate any member of his/her staff to act as Hearing Officer. For transparency purposes, the president of the homeowners association concerned or his/her authorized designee shall automatically act as active voting member during the conduct of hearing;
- b) The Hearing Officer upon receiving his/her designation shall immediately prepare a complaint of the violation and furnish a copy to the respondent beneficiary with the instruction to submit an answer or comment on the complaint within ten (10) days upon the receipt of the complaint;
- c) Upon the receipt of the answer of the respondent beneficiary and the Hearing Officer is satisfied with the answer, he/she shall immediately terminate the investigation and prepare his/her corresponding recommendation/s to the CHUDD Department Head through the Division Head for approval. If the Hearing Officer is dissatisfied with the answer or if the Department Head denies the recommendation, the Hearing Officer shall set the hearing not more than ten (10) days from the receipt of the answer;
- d) The respondent beneficiary may avail of the legal services of a legal counsel of his/her own choice during the hearing;
- e) During the hearing and in the presence of respondent-beneficiary with or without his/her counsel, the Hearing Officer shall require the respondent to submit his/her position paper and make available to him/her any report or recommendation, if the beneficiary desires, showing proofs of the violation committed;
- f) The Hearing Officer shall secure proofs and affidavit/s of witnesses to prove that the respondent-beneficiary has committed the violation in the complaint;
- g) If in any case the respondent-beneficiary cannot be found, the Hearing Officer shall



proceed to hear the case and shall submit his decision within fifteen (15) days from the submission of the complaint of violation;

- h) A copy of the Hearing Officer's decision shall be submitted to the CHUDD Department Head for approval and shall furnish a copy thereof to the City Council, Respondent-Beneficiary, and the City Legal Office;
- i) The respondent-beneficiary may appeal the decision to the City Mayor within ten (10) days after the receipt of the decision in a Memorandum of Appeal;
- j) The defendant and/or parties may appeal the decision to the City Mayor within ten (10) days from the receipt of the decision of the Hearing Officer.
 - i. The City Mayor upon receipt of the Memorandum of Appeal shall render decision thereof within ten (10) days and thereafter issue the corresponding Order for the purpose;
 - ii. The decision of the City Mayor shall be final and immediately executory.

SECTION 10. Implementing Rules and Regulations - Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Ordinance, the CHUDD shall formulate the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) necessary for the effective implementation of the provisions of this Ordinance and submit the same to the City Mayor for approval and furnish copy thereof to the City Council.

SECTION 11. Repealing Clause - All ordinances, provisions of local ordinances, executive orders, and similar issuances, that are contrary to or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 12. Severability - If any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, inconsistent or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other parts or provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 13. Suppletory Clause - The pertinent provisions of the following ordinances shall apply in a suppletory manner hereof; *Provided*, that these are not contrary to the intent and provisions of this Ordinance, to wit:

- a) Ordinance No. 13178 - 2016 (An ordinance consolidating and further amending Ordinance No. 9888-2005 and Ordinance No. 10046-2006, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Socialized Housing Program for the underprivileged and nameless citizens of Cagayan de Oro City, formerly Piso-Piso Program, so as to provide therein additional guidelines and to provide penalty for violation thereof and for other purposes), as amended by Ordinance No. 13319-2017;
- b) Ordinance No. 13717-2019 (An ordinance establishing policies and guidelines in the titling of lots and awarding of housing units at various relocation sites to Typhoon Sendong victim-beneficiaries; and for other purposes).

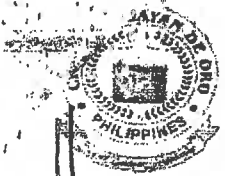
