WHEREAS, Cagayan de Oro has been using the ICS not only during disasters or large-scale emergencies but also during planned events or activities in the city to efficiently and effectively manage resources such as facilities, equipment, and personnel interoperating as one to achieve a common operational objective.

SIR:

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing in response to your letter dated May 20, 2024 regarding the water consumption from the temporary installation at the City Memorial Park, which was intended for use during the COVID-19 pandemic.

We acknowledge the necessity and urgency of the temporary water installation during the pandemic. We understand that this installation was crucial in providing necessary water services during an unprecedented time, and we appreciate your cooperation and effort in managing public health and safety.

However, it has come to our attention that the water installation at the City Memorial Park continued to be used beyond the designated pandemic period. The continued use of this unregistered connection beyond its intended purpose have contributed to the Non-Revenue Water that we have been working to reduce.

This consumption has been monitored randomly during pandemic and religiously in the post-pandemic period by our Meter Reader and was observed to be used by the Embalming Services of the City Memorial Park as confirmed by a certain Mr. Ferdinand Magallanes from the stated park. As a gesture of goodwill and in recognition of the extraordinary circumstances, we have decided to waive the charges for water consumption incurred during the pandemic period.

Moving forward, we must address the ongoing use of this water installation. We find it necessary to bill your office for its continued use of this water installation. To ensure compliance with our regulations and to facilitate a proper and permanent water service connection, we kindly request the City Government to complete the necessary documentation and installation fees of its water service application for the continued use of this water service. KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement executed by and between:

The City Government of Cagayan de Oro, a local government unit created and existing under and by virtue of Philippine law, with principal office address at City Hall, 2nd Floor, Executive Building, City Hall, Cagayan de Oro City, Philippines, represented herein by its City Mayor, ROLANDO 'KLAREX' A. UY, hereinafter referred to as City Mayor of Cagayan de Oro City;

Department of Education, a national government agency created and existing under and by virtue of Philippine law, with office address at Department of Education Regional Office, Zone 1, Upper Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, Philippines, represented herein by its Regional Director, ARTURO B. BAYOCOT, herein after referred to as DepEd Region X;

WITNESSETH: that

WHEREAS, COA Circular No. 94-013 dated December 31, 1994 provides for the rules and regulations in the grant, utilization and liquidation of funds transferred to implementing agencies.

Dear Ms. Tongson:

This pertains to the legal review of the proposed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Local Government Unit of Cagayan de Oro (LGU- CDOC) thru the City Social Welfare and Development Department (CSWD) and the Development of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) for the Technical Assistance and Resource Augmentation.

In this connection; kindly be informed that this Office has thoroughly reviewed the above-mentioned proposed MOA and finds it legally sound and thus poses no legal objection to the same, except with the following legal recommendation/s as follows:

In connection with the provisions of DEFAULT, DELAY AND BREACHES, this office otherwise recommends an ARBITRATION CLAUSE instead. This is in consideration that both parties are acting in their governmental functions and government offices as well. It is deemed conveyed to the other party to insert this clause, as follows:

"Any dispute, controversy, difference or claim arising out of or in relation to this agreement, including any question as to the interpretation, implementation, existence, validity, breach or termination thereof or as to any non-contractual obligation arising out of or relating thereto, shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration Rules in force at the time of the commencement of the arbitration, which rules are deemed incorporated by reference in this clause.

In addition, the following provision is deemed advised to be included in the MOA, as follows:

NO STRICT CONSTRUCTION

The Parties acknowledge that they have agreed amongst each other in good faith and at arms-length with respect to the terms, conditions and provisions hereof, that each Party has determined for himself or herself that this Agreement is fair and reasonable, and that the words and phrases in this Agreement express the true intentions of all the Parties so that no rule of strict construction should be applied when interpreting and construing this Agreement.



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS:

This MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made and entered into by and between:

The **DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT**, a National Government Agency with office address at **DSWD Central Office**, Constitution Hills, Batasan Complex, Quezon City, Philippines represented by its Secretary, **HON. REXLON T. GATCHALIAN**, herein referred to as "**the DSWD**";

- and -

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, a local government unit organized and existing by virtue of its Charter under Republic Act No. 521 and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, with office address at City Hall, Cagayan de Oro City, duly represented herein by its Local Chief Executive, **HON. ROLANDO "KLAREX" A. UY**, hereinafter referred to as the "**LGU-CDOC**."

WITNESSETH

Whereas, Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that Local Government Units shall exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the social welfare services and facilities which include programs and projects on child and youth welfare, family and community welfare, women's welfare, welfare of the elderly and disabled persons; community-based rehabilitation programs for vagrants, beggars, street children, scavengers, juvenile delinquents, and victims of drug abuse; livelihood and other pro-poor projects; nutrition services; and family planning services;

Whereas, pursuant to Sangguniang Resolution No. ____, Series of 2024, HON. ROLANDO "KLAREX" A. UY has been authorized to sign and execute the foregoing MOA on behalf of the LGU-CDOC;

Whereas, Executive Order No. 15, s. 1998, as amended by Executive Order No. 221, s. 2003 states that the DSWD is mandated to provide assistance to local government units (LGUs), non-government organizations (NGOs), other national government agencies (NGAs), people's organizations (POs) in effectively implementing programs, projects, and services that will alleviate poverty and empower disadvantaged individuals, families, and communities for an improved quality of life as well as implement statutory and specialized programs which are directly lodged with the Department and/or not yet devolved to LGUs;

Whereas, DSWD Memorandum Circular No. 10, s. 2018 provides that the DSWD assists LGUs/Local Social Welfare and Development Offices by providing direction for the SWD sector through pertinent policies and plans enriching SWD programs and services for individuals, families, and communities at risk or in need, and, affording social protection for the poor, the vulnerable and the disadvantaged in localities. These undertakings are manifested through the Technical Assistance and Resource Augmentation (TARA) Program of the DSWD;

Whereas, under the TARA program of the same MC, **Technical Assistance (TA)** consists of non-monetary interventions in the following forms, which are designed to enhance the capability of LSWDOs based on needs assessment, for the effective implementation of SWD programs, projects, and services such as training, training of trainers, orientation, demonstration session, workshop, forum, consultation or sharing session, conference, coaching and mentoring.

Whereas, pursuant to DSWD Administrative Order No. 02, s. 2024 with subject, "Adopting and Implementing the DSWD Strategic Plan from 2024-2028", one of the strategic objectives of the Department is to increase the capacities of LGUs in the social welfare and development services through enhancing the design and implementation of TAAORSS and institutionalization of Reward and Incentive Package of LGUs."

Whereas, the LGU-CDOC shall submit its 3-year Technical Assistance Plan to the DSWD for which shall serve as the basis of the DSWD in the provision of non-monetary interventions to the LGU-CDOC to enhance the capability of LSWDOs for the effective implementation of SWD programs, projects and services.

Whereas, the DSWD and LGU-CDOC share a common vision to protect, promote, and uphold the welfare and interest of the poor, vulnerable, and disadvantaged individuals, families, and communities;

Whereas, the DSWD is committed to provide the necessary technical assistance to LGU-CDOC pursuant to the approved 3-year plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties have agreed to commit themselves the following:

1. The DSWD shall:
 - a. Provide technical assistance to LGU-CDOC along the areas specified in the TA Plan which shall include but not limited to: 1) training, 2) orientation, 3) workshop, 4) forum, 5) conference, 6) coaching, and 7) mentoring.
 - b. Provide rewards and incentives on the best practices of LGU-CDOC through the Pagkilala sa Natatanging Kontribusyon sa Bayan (Panata ko sa Bayan Awards under DSWD Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 18, series of 2023, with subject, "Supplemental Guidelines on Memorandum Circular No. 1, series of 2017 – Revised Guidelines on the Pagkilala sa Natatanging Kontribusyon Awards on the Provision of Rewards and Incentives to Local Government Units through Local Social Welfare and Development Offices (LSWDOs) on Social Welfare and Development Local Implementation."
 - c. Conduct service delivery capacity assessment pursuant to DSWD MC No. 10, series of 2018, or the "Guidelines on the Provision of Technical Assistance to Local Government Units Through Local Social Welfare and Development Offices, which shall be scheduled and agreed upon between the parties"
 - d. Monitor the progress and accomplishments of LGU-CDOC in reference to the LGU TA Plan.
2. The LGU-CDOC shall:
 - a. Submit a 3-Year TA Plan (template attached as Annex "A"), approved and signed by the LCE and the LSWDO Head, to the DSWD through the concerned Regional Director, within 5 days upon execution of this MOA."
 - b. Make available the necessary counterpart staff, logistics and/or funds to enable the DSWD to support the TA Plan;
 - c. Assist the DSWD in the annual monitoring of the TA Plan to identify and address implementation gaps, problems or issues;
3. The parties may jointly conduct annual review of the TA Program implementation, based on the formulated 3-Year TA plan; and,
4. No amendment or modification to this Agreement shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of both parties."

Arbitration

Any dispute, controversy, difference or claim out of or in relation to this agreement, including any question as to the interpretation, implementation, existence, validity, breach or termination thereof or as to any non-contractual obligation arising out of or relating thereto, shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration Rules in force at the time of the commencement of the arbitration, which rules are deemed incorporated by reference in this clause.

No Strict Construction

The Parties acknowledge that they agreed amongst each other in good faith and at arms-length with respect to the terms, conditions and provisions hereof, that each Party has determined for himself or herself that this Agreement is fair and reasonable, and that the words and phrases in this Agreement express the true intentions of all the Parties so that no rule of strict construction should be applied when interpreting and construing this Agreement.

Validity and Termination

This agreement shall take effect upon its execution and shall remain valid for a period of three (3) years, unless earlier revoked or pre-terminated by their mutual consent.
